Ayaaz Hossain. Faraaz, a student of Emory University in Atlanta, US, was brutally killed by terrorists during the July 1 attack at the Holey Artisan Bakery in Gulshan in 2016.

Latifur was the founding director of Mediaworld, the company that owns The Daily Star, and chairman of Mediastar, the owning company of Prothom Alo. The newspapers are the leading English and Bangla dailies in the country.

A respected figure in the global business community, he single-handedly built one of the biggest business conglomerates in the country with his hard work, perseverance, and entrepreneurial skills.

Born in Jalgajuri on August 28, 1945, he began his education at St Francis School and then went to St Edmund's School, Shillong, in 1956. He also studied at St Xavier's College in Calcutta (now Kolkata).

After coming to Dhaka, he started as a trainee at his family-owned jute mills -- W Rahman Jute Mills in Chandpur -- in 1966. The jute mill was the first to be owned by a Bangalee in the erstwhile East Pakistan.

He became an executive and worked there until 1971. But the government nationalised industries in 1972 and Latifur found himself in a very difficult situation. The family also owned some tea estates in north-eastern Bangladesh but after the independence the price of produce was less than production cost.

Chunu said teachers are being humiliated by their own students, as the environment at the country's education institutions has been ruined.

The JP MP said there is no monitoring system of University Grants Commission for mismanagement and irregularities in private and public universities.

Pointing to the killing of a college teacher in Savar and humiliation of a teacher in Narail, JP MP Kazi Firoz Rashid

questioned, "What is happening in educational institutions today?"

BNP MP Harunur Rashid said, "Quality of education has deteriorated, breaking all records."

Harun said not a single university has been placed in the international ranking.

All the opposition MPs blasted the government for insufficient allocation of the proposed budget for education sector.

On behalf of the education minister, Agriculture Minister Abdur Razzaque told the

parliament that the present situation will not improve overnight.

Harunur said in the last 10 years, people have lost confidence in the EC. Not the EC but police and the administration are holding elections at present.

Another BNP MP Rumeen Farhah said the EC has been destroyed under the present government, and voting under the present EC cannot be free and fair.

The law, home and health ministers refuted all the allegations of the opposition MPs.

my life. In just two days, everything was submerged in water. There was some dry rice in the house, which got wet and now, they're probably rotten."

Sarada Biswas (45), a resident of Talimpur in Barlekha Upazila in Moulvibazar, said she and her family are currently living on the roadside bridge. "We have nothing to eat. I was only able to fetch a couple of clothes and my cattle. We had no other place to stay. I'm spending days in my torn, wet clothes."

Popy Begum (18), who took shelter at a centre in Kulaura, said although relief is coming through,

hardly any hygiene and sanitary products are being provided. As a result, many girls are facing trouble during their periods at the shelter.

Sajan Mia of Tangar Haor said since the floods, they can't focus on child development separately. "I'm not even able to pay attention to my pregnant wife properly."

Pritam Das, coordinator of the Bibeki Tarunyo, a relief-based organisation, said although relief is being provided in different parts of Sylhet, women and children are facing a lack of proper food.

Dr Mohammad Noore

Alam Shamim, assistant director of health directorate (Sylhet), said, "Most women and children feel uncomfortable voicing out what their major needs and concerns are. Hence, they need special attention during floods."

In a declaration paper, the participants mentioned that controlling corruption remains something on the papers only as most of the time people of political influence are found involved. 12 at departure. Their operation began on June 7. The airport's database shows that 6,576 passengers departed and 2,108 arrived using e-gates from June 7 to June 23.

Brig Gen Sadat Hossain, project director of e-passport and automated border control management project, said e-gates are capable of verifying passports and their carriers' authenticity within a short time. Six e-gates have been installed

at Chattogram airport, and one each at Benapole and Bangabandha airport.

Presently, the e-gates are being used for scanning passports and their carriers.

But the authority is working to integrate other information, including boarding time, departure details, Bureau of Manpower, Employment and Training details for expatriates, e-visa details and travel history.

Group Captain Kamrul Islam, executive director

of HSIA, said they are working and are hopeful to complete the process within a year.

Shahriar Alam, special superintendent of police's Special Branch, said full benefits of the gates will come when machine-readable passports are completely phased out.

Shahriar said traffickers may try to misuse the system, especially when it comes to countries that do not require visas. "We remain alert to avert such activities."
