

8.58pc pass DU ‘D’ unit entry test

Only 8.58 percent students passed the Dhaka University “D” unit admission test under Social Science Faculty for 2021-22 academic year, according to the results published yesterday.

A total of 6,111 students amongst 71,262 aspirants passed the test, competing for 1,336 seats.

The test was held on June 11.

The authorities have urged those who passed in the entry test to fill up the subject choice form between July 7 to July 28 through the university’s admission test website.

The participants are: Nuzhat Ahmed Disha from Viqarunnisa Noon School and College, SMA Nahian from Shamsul Hoque Khan School and College, Ashrafur Islam Fahim and Tahmid Hamim Chowdhury from Notre Dame College, Fuad Al Alam from Dhaka Residential Model College, and Tahjib Hossain Khan from Ananda Mohan College, Mymensingh.

Sultana, Naoki to get ‘Bangabandhu Medal’

Bangladesh Ambassador to Poland Sultana Laila Hossain and Japanese Ambassador to Bangladesh Ito Naoki will be conferred “Bangabandhu Medal for Diplomatic Excellence” for their significant contribution to diplomacy.

The awards will be given at the inaugural of the new building of the foreign ministry tomorrow.

Sultana has successfully handled exodus of hundreds of Bangladeshis in one of the largest migration crisis in Europe, following the Russian aggression in Ukraine in February. Naoki, meanwhile, has been playing an important role in boosting bilateral relationship.

Better call Galib!

DB arrests fraudster who duped people in guise of police

Galib is a problem solver of sorts. He deals with police-related issues, like releasing someone from custody and ensuring that an accused is not beaten while in remand.

For his “services”, Tk 25,000 is deposited into his mobile financial service (MFS) accounts every day on average. How much he got through his bank accounts is still not known.

Besides these, he takes a hefty amount from several dozens of vehicles, to ensure that they can easily pass police check-posts.

For years, the 46-year-old Galib Chowdhury Khokon, using the fake identity of an assistant inspector general (AIG) of Police Headquarters, has been duping police and people in general.

To do this, he has maintained

area-based sources to get information and a bodyguard to do his personal work.

The bodyguard is paid a monthly salary of Tk 10,000 and accommodation.

The financial crime investigation team of cyber and special crime division of police’s detective branch (DB) has come to know about all this after arresting Galib from the capital’s Sabujbagh area on Monday.

Police also arrested his bodyguard Md Liaqat Ali (35) and one of his sources Saiful Chowdhury (37).

Mohidul Islam, additional deputy commissioner of the

division, said they got to know about Galib after he took around Tk 85,000 from the father of an accused. Galib had promised that the accused would not be placed in remand.

“He was involved in such frauds for the last several years. For different types of activities, he used to charge different amounts.”

For instance, he took Tk 5,000 to release a document-less bike from police, and Tk 20,000 to call an officer-in-charge (OC) to arrest an accused who has a warrant against them.

“After analysing six months’ statements of Galib’s three MFS



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EVM not reliable Says Shujan report

Electronic Voting Machine (EVM) is a shabby tool and it is depriving people of their voting rights, said Sushasoner Jonno Nagorik (Shujan) Secretary Badiul Alam Majumdar at a press conference yesterday.

“In the 2017 Cumilla City Corporation election, 64 percent of the votes were cast in the paper ballot. This time, 59 percent of the total votes were cast using EVM. When it comes to voting on EVM, many people went back after failing to cast their votes as their biometric impressions did not match. In such cases, EVMs have deprived people of the right to vote,” said Badiul.

He said this during unveiling of a report on the newly-elected councillors and mayor of Cumilla City Corporation polls at Dhaka Reporters Unity (DRU).

He said in the 2018 general elections, around 81 percent of votes were cast in the 294 constituencies in which paper ballots were used. In the other six constituencies, where votes were cast using EVMs, 51 percent of votes were cast.

“That is a difference of 30 percent, which means that either there were manipulations using paper ballots or people were deprived of the right to vote where EVMs were used,” said Badiul.

Speakers at the event also said it is not possible to hold the upcoming parliamentary polls in a participatory manner if the political parties’ confidence in the EC is not restored.

In their report, Shujan mentioned that almost 62 percent of the elected in the polls are

46 more hospitalised with dengue

At least 46 dengue patients were admitted to different hospitals across the country in the last 24 hours that ended at 8:00am yesterday.

With the 46 new cases (three from outside Dhaka) the total number of dengue patients rose to 1,284, according to DGHS. Among the patients, 152 are still undergoing treatment. A total of 1,131 patients have been released from hospitals and one patient has died so far.

Govt sends aid for quake victims in Afghanistan

Bangladesh yesterday sent emergency relief materials including biscuits, noodles, powdered milk, tents and medicines to Afghanistan for the earthquake victims.

Over a thousand Afghans were killed, some 2,000 seriously injured and thousands of others became homeless with their houses completely destroyed in the earthquake in Afghanistan’s eastern region on 22 June.
