CPB demands after arson  
attack in Khagrachhari

Communist Party of Bangladesh (CPB) yesterday demanded justice regarding the attack and torching of 37 houses of ethnic-minority people in Khagrachhari’s Mahalchhari upazila.

In a statement, CPB president Shah Alam and general secretary Ruhin Hossain Prince said the number of attacks and kidnappings in hill areas increased rapidly, but the government failed to ensure safety of minorities.

At least 37 houses of ethnic minorities were set on fire on Tuesday, over a land dispute between them and settlers at Joysen Para in Mahalchhari. About five people were also reportedly injured in the incident.

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Cattle markets in Kutupalong, Ukhiya, Teknaf and other areas have been abuzz with Rohingya people. Many were seen inspecting prices, while others bought their preferred animal for sacrifice. This photo was taken on Wednesday from TV Tower cattle market.

Cattle markets  
near Rohingya  
camps buzzing

With Eid getting ever closer, Rohingya camps have been in a festive mood lately, as many were seen buying animals for sacrifice in nearby cattle markets.

At least 10 cattle markets – including those in Kutupalong, Ukhiya, Morichya, Palongkhali, Thengkhali, Balukhali, and Teknaf’s Hnila, Huyaikkong and Leda – have been growing larger as each year passes by.

This correspondent visited Kutupalong and Ukhiya’s TV Tower cattle markets and talked with a few customers.

Hossen Mia, a resident of Kutupalong Camp-02, went to Kutupalong Bazar to look for a medium-sized buffalo or bull for Eid.

“My elder brother lives in Malaysia. He sent us some money for Eid with his savings. I managed to save from own my income as well, and we decided to offer sacrifice,” he said.

Shahidur Rahman (45), a local cattle trader from Lambaghona of Haldiapalong union, brought 26 buffaloes from TV Tower cattle market to sell it off to Rohingya people.

“I’ve been coming here since the Rohingya influx took place to sell cattle. Since Tuesday, I sold off 10 buffaloes. Most Rohingyas who bought buffaloes said they had an expat relative abroad,” he said.

Shahid informed most Rohingyas chose small- to medium-sized cattle for sacrifice.

Helal Uddin, Rajapalong union parishad member – which hosts four camps – said Rohingyas along with the Bangalee community are buying cattle for Eid.

But Imrul Kayes Chowdhury, chairperson of Haldiapalong Union Parishad, had a different opinion regarding their purchasing power.

“Livestock office says, the demand for sacrificial animals in Ukhiya upazila is 9,000, whereas we have only 8,000 available. Sometimes, this affects locals’ ability to buy cattle,” he said.

He claimed many Rohingyas are involved with the yaba trade, which may have increased their purchasing capacity.

Dr Asim Sen, livestock officer of Ukhiya, said they have 23,000 animals in stock, which is enough for locals.

Shamsud Douza Nayan, additional commissioner of Refugee Relief and Repatriation Commissioner Office, said they have a designated place for sacrificing at Rohingya camps.

“Last year, 3,000 animals were sacrificed. This time, it could be close to that figure or a bit lower,” he added.

Government to  
start project on  
religious harmony  
Says state minister for  
religious affairs

The government will implement a nationwide “Religious Harmony and Awareness” project through education and cultural activism involving women, youth, civil society, community and faith leaders to further promote the culture of peace, tolerance and inclusiveness, said State Minister for Religious Affairs Faridul Haque Khan.

He was speaking at the “2022 International Ministerial Conference on Freedom of Religion or Belief”, hosted by the UK government in London from July 5-6, according to a statement of the Bangladesh High Commission in the UK yesterday.

The conference brought together faith and belief leaders, governments, parliamentarians, and civil society organisations from 100 countries to take global action to promote freedom of religion or belief for all.

At the event, Faridul also highlighted Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina’s zero-tolerance policy on discrimination or violence against religious minorities, as he was delivering the country statement.

He said Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman founded a democratic and secular people’s republic in 1971, but the spirit was destroyed by communal forces following his brutal assassination in 1975.

His daughter Hasina restored religious freedom in the constitution as the cornerstone of the country’s secular identity and took various initiatives to ensure religious freedom.


