Parents, kazi sentenced to jail for six months

The parents of two minors and a marriage registrar (kazi) have been sentenced to six months' imprisonment for their involvement in marriage in Bagerhat.

Bagerhat Sadar Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) Muhammad Mushabberul Islam gave the sentence after conducting a mobile court at the office of marriage registrar Ataul Bari in Nagerbazar area of Bagerhat town on Friday

Dhaka air quality remains 'moderate'

Dhaka's air continues to be in the "moderate" zone.

With an air quality index (AQI) score of 59 at 8:56am yesterday, the metropolis ranked 23rd in the list of world cities with the worst

air quality. An AQI between 50 and 100 is considered "moderate" with acceptable air quality.

África's South Johannesburg, Pakistan's Lahore and Iran's Tehran occupied the first three spots in the list, with AQI scores of 172, 160, 148, respectively.

An AQI between 101 and 200 is considered "unhealthy".

Similarly, an AQI between 201 and 300 is Similarly. said to be 'poor', while a reading of 301 to 400 is "hazardous", considered posing serious health risks to residents.



Dhaka-bound passengers from the country's northern regions had to go through a painful wait yesterday, as trains on Dhaka-Panchagarh route got delayed for almost six hours due to a technical glitch. RAIL TRACK OF PADMA BRIDGE

Railway aims to finish installation by Dec

The project authority of Padma Bridge will start handing over the structure to the railway's authority today so that the latter can start installing rail track on the lower deck of the bridge.

Now both the agency will carry out a joint survey and it may take up to one week to complete the handing over

The railway authorities are expected to start installing rail track within two weeks, officials

The development came as officials of Bangladesh Railway (BR), Bangladesh Bridge Authority, project officials held a meeting at Mawa Service Area in Munshiganj yesterday, they said.

Md Kamruzzaman, deputy project director (technical) of Padma Multipurpose Bridge Project said they will hand over the relevant portion of the bridge to railway authorities today.

"It may take up to one week to complete the handing over process," the official told The Daily Star vesterday. Afzal Hossain, project director of Padma Bridge Rail

Link Project, said they will start a joint survey as a part

of receiving the structure and it may take up to two to

start installation of track.

BR is implementing the rail link project to build a 169-km rail line from Dhaka to Jashore through the Padma Bridge at a cost of around Tk 40,000 crore. The double-decker bridge -- roadway on the top and

rail line on the bottom, was opened to traffic last month. BBA implement the bridge project but railway will install rail tack on lower deck of the bridge under the rail link project.

"We will try to complete installation of rail line on around 7km length on the bridge and its connecting portion within December this year," Afzal said.

BR had a plan to launch train operation along with the road operation on Mawa-Bhanga section but later changed the decision as BBA declined to handover the bridge before opening due to "technical reasons".

Visiting the project site on Friday, Railways Minister Nurul Islam Sujan said the install of track on the bridge would be started this week.

He also hoped that the train operation from Dhaka to Bhanga via the bridge would be started by June next

Flood death toll now 121

The death toll from the devastating floods in the country rose to 121 with two more deaths in Sylhet district in 24 hours till vesterday morning.

The latest victims drowned in floodwater, according to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS).

Of the total deceased, 94 people drowned in floodwater, 15 were killed by lightning, two died from snake bites, one from diarrhoea, and nine due to other reasons.

Of the deceased, 67 people died in Sylhet, 41 in Mymensingh, 12 in Rangpur and one in Dhaka

Of a total of 70 flood-hit upazilas, 33 are in Sylhet division, 16 in Rangpur division, 20 in Mymensingh division and one in Chattogram

Sylhet, Sunamganj, Netrokona and Kurigram are the worst-hit districts, with 13, 11, 10 and nine upazilas of the districts respectively affected by

Man stabbed to death

A man was stabbed to death on Friday night in Dinajpur's Hakimpur upazila, said police.

The deceased is Bahauddin Sarkar (35) of Mathpara village.

Quoting locals, police said Bahauddin was sitting in front of a local club on Friday night. Suddenly, a youth named Md Emon appeared and locked in an altercation with him.

At one point, Emon pulled out a knife, stabbed Bahauddin and fled the spot.

Locals said the two had previous enmity. Bahauddin passed away on way to a hospital, said Shariful Islam, inspector (Investigation) of

Hakimpur police station.

He said police are looking for Emon, who is on the run. A case was filed.
