PKSF ensures potable water for 250 families in Khulna

Palli Karma-Sahayak Foundation has ensured drinkable water for the residents of Koyra upazila in Khulna.
Lawmaker Gloria Jharna Sarker inaugurated a reverse osmosis (RO) plant, set up with financial and technical support from PKSF, in the area on July 27, said a press release.
The coastal district faces serious crisis of potable water due to salinity and rising sea level following climate change.
PKSF has so far installed 70 RO plants to ensure pure drinking water in Bagerhat, Barguna, Khulna, Satkhira, Patuakhali and Pirojpur.



The key feature of these plants is that they collect water from open sources rather than extracting groundwater.
The plant can produce enough water (1,000 litres per hour) to meet the demand of some 250 families on a regular basis.

KCC budget for this fiscal Tk 861cr

Khulna City Corporation (KCC) yesterday announced a budget of Tk 861.06 crore for fiscal 2022-23.
Mayor Talukder Abdul Khaleque stated the budget at the corporation's Shaheed Altaf Auditorium.
No new tax will be imposed on city dwellers.
In the proposed budget, revenue expenditure has been estimated to be Tk 192.11 crore, and expenditure in the development sector is Tk 668.94 crore. In fiscal 2021-22, the target budget was Tk 608.02 crore. In the revised budget, the amount stood at Tk 450.68 crore.
The mayor emphasised development of roads, drainage and waste management, and many more issues.

Three killed

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Mymensingh highway at Boiler in Trishal upazila yesterday afternoon.
Noor Alam, son of Babul Mia from Rampurdasha village in Barhata upazila in Netrakona, died on the spot, said police quoting locals.
The accident happened while he was doing repair work on a road divider, they said.

Family rejects probe

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Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court fixed October 30 for hearing.
On May 3 last year, Sheikh Mozizul Islam, an inspector of Turag Police Station, submitted the charge sheet to the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court of Dhaka, accusing Mohammad Selim alias Anis Howlader, an assistant engineer of the city corporation, and his two accomplices — Helal Howlader and Habibur

Rahman Khan. Selim secured ad-interim bail from the HC on June 29.
According to the charge sheet, Delwar was killed over a disagreement with his colleague Selim over the latter's illegal activities.
Police recovered Delwar's body from an empty plot of Uttara Sector-17 near Beribadh on May 11, 2020.
Khodeja filed the murder case with Turag Police Station, accusing some unidentified people.

"On the morning of July 23, I received a call on Whatsapp, probably from a US number, and was hurled with abusive words. The man introduced himself as Raihan and asked why I revealed the information," he said.

Sub-inspector Rana Pratap of the station has been looking into the GD, he added.
Rab-11 has already arrested three persons in connection with the smuggling. Officials said two persons who are directly involved with the syndicate managed to flee to Dubai soon after the arrest.
