Ten Lankans missing from Commonwealth Games

Ten members of crisis-hit Sri Lanka's Commonwealth Games contingent in Birmingham have disappeared in a suspected attempt to remain in Britain, a top sports official from the island nation told AFP on Sunday.

The nine athletes and a manager vanished after completing their events, the official said, requesting anonymity. Three of them had disappeared last week.

That prompted a police complaint by the Sri Lankan officials. "Since then, another seven have vanished," the official said, without identifying them. "We suspect they want to remain in the UK, possibly to get employment."

The 160-strong Sri Lankan contingent's management possessed the passports of all members to ensure they returned home.

That failed to deter some from leaving. British police located the first three that disappeared, but as they had not violated local laws and held visas valid for six months, no action was taken, the Sri Lankan official told AFP.



Medvedev ends losing streak in finals

World number one Daniil Medvedev ended his losing run in finals with a 7-5, 6-0 win over Britain's Cameron Norrie on Saturday to lift the title in Los Cabos, Mexico, and ramp up preparations for his U.S. Open title defence.

A ban on Russian players at Wimbledon due to Russia's invasion of Ukraine forced Medvedev to miss the grasscourt major and he arrived in Mexico for the ATP 250 event for his first tournament since June.

Most of Medvedev's success over the years have come on hardcourts and he did not lose a set this week en route to his first title of the season.

The Russian came into the contest against last year's champion Norrie, ranked 12th in the world, having lost five straight finals dating back to last year's Paris Masters in November.

Sikandar Raza, who also hit a hundred in the first ODI, and Zimbabwe captain Regis Chakabva struck tons and strung a 201-run stand off 169 balls for the fifth-wicket as the hosts successfully chased 291 to clinch the three-match ODI series against Bangladesh with a game in hand.

Sikandar Raza's splendid second consecutive hundred, along with skipper Regis Chakabva's maiden ODI ton, led Zimbabwe to a five-wicket victory against Bangladesh in the second ODI in Harare yesterday, thereby sealing the three-match ODI series with a game in hand. It was the hosts' first ODI series win against Bangladesh after nine years.

Much like the first game where Raza got a century-scoring partner in Innocent Kaia, the right-hander paired with Regis Chakabva as both scored centuries in a record 201-run fifth wicket stand after Zimbabwe were struggling at one stage at 49 for four inside 15 overs.

Chakabva, however, departed after scoring his century but Raza made sure his side continued the fine run and remained unbeaten on 117 off 127 balls. Debutant Tony Munyonga's 30-run cameo led to the celebrations for Zimbabwe at the Harare Sports Club.

Bangladesh, posted 303 and 290 in the two ODIs, but none of the batters were able to score a hundred. According to Bangladesh captain Tamim Iqbal, the four hundreds in the two games by the

Zimbabwe batters made the difference. Tamim, however, added that 290 was a good total to defend but the visitors were unable to execute their plans.

"The difference is four hundreds for them and zero for us. We put a decent total. We got a good start but no one continued. In the first game, we thought we had an opportunity to score twenty more runs and today after the small collapse, Afif and Mahmudullah did well. We thought 290 was a good total to defend but we couldn't execute ourselves," Tamim said at the post-match presentation ceremony yesterday.

Bangladesh's fielding was once again below-par and the bowling was bite-less even though they managed to remove the Zimbabwe top order early in the chase.

Tamim, though, gave credit to Zimbabwe for a brilliant display in the two games.

"The wicket was good from the beginning. It wasn't easy against the spinners. All credit to Zimbabwe, they were the better team this series. We have to pull up our socks. We haven't played our best cricket and that's why we are in this position," he said.

The series defeat is a huge blow for Bangladesh as the fifty-over format is believed to be their favoured format, and also due to their dominance over Zimbabwe in recent years.

It was also Tamim's second series defeat after being appointed as the skipper of the Tigers' ODI side in 2020.

It means a lot, though, for Zimbabwe who have been playing a positive brand of cricket in recent times.

"(The series win) is massive, we've been playing some good cricket. We were itching to play good cricket. To win the series, it's really nice. We've been trying to play positive cricket. The coaches asked me to take it deep and I batted positively. We have to play good cricket again, we'll be looking to win (the final ODI)," said Chakabva.



Samukonga, Williams win historic golds

Zambian teenager Muzala Samukonga won his nation's first-ever Commonwealth Games 400m title on Sunday as Sada Williams gave Barbados their first gold in the women's event on the final day of athletics in Birmingham.

Samukonga, 19, who timed 44.66sec, exited the stadium in a wheelchair after tripping over a low advertising hoarding as he ran to collect his national flag.

Williams outclassed Victoria Ohuruogu, who missed out on emulating her elder sister, 2008 Olympic gold medallist Christine, who won Commonwealth gold in 2006.

Williams, 24, who won bronze at the recent world championships, set a new Games record of 49.90sec, with Ohuruogu taking silver.

"It's amazing (to be part of the Barbados team)," said Williams. "I am so proud of Jonathan (Jones who won bronze in the men's 400m).

Haaland scores double on PL debut

New Manchester City signing Erling Haaland marked his Premier League debut with a double as the champions began their title defence with a clinical 2-0 victory over West Ham United at the London Stadium on Sunday.

Pep Guardiola's City were awarded a penalty after 36 minutes when Haaland charged past the

West Ham defence to latch onto a through ball and take it around the box before being fouled by the substitute goalkeeper.

The Norwegian striker stepped up to convert the spot kick, his cool finish sending

Areola the wrong way to give City a deserved lead after an utterly dominant first half in which West Ham were rarely able to venture from their own box.

City midfielder Kevin De Bruyne then defended a series of crosses before slipping through a delightful pin-point pass to Haaland, who timed his run to perfection and slotted home with a fine left-footed finish in the 65th minute.
