The most prolific money-making superstar of cricket, Becash All Hashi, has decided to no longer apologise to his fans after extending his own world record for most official apologies made by a professional athlete in any sport.

At the time of writing, the team gathered at the Merepoor Stadium for the official photo shoot for the World Cup but skipper Becash was absent.

The B,CB officials acted all surprised when one of the reporters from The Daily Nebula pointed out that Becash was busy being the chief guest at IIT's freshers' orientation programme, according to his latest Instagram post.

Make one egg last 3 meals: Ministry publishes guideline after price hike

Helmets made compulsory in district town

Mostish Kokhali, a local political leader, yesterday called a press conference in Coolna to announce that there would be no shortage of helmets and everyone walking the streets will have to wear them in the district town.
