affected host communities, and is so far funded at only 49 percent, with US \$426.2 million received, the UNHCR said.

The international community must redouble efforts for increased political dialogue and diplomatic engagement to create conditions for their voluntary, safe, dignified and sustainable return, it added.

Mofazzal Hossain, a Chattogram-bound bus passenger, said, "I had to walk a kilometre because of huge gridlocks. I will have to walk more to find other buses."

Contacted, Sitakunda UNO Shahadat Hossain told this correspondent, "We tried evacuating the demonstrators out of the highway by reassuring them. However, they did not listen."

This correspondent talked to the demonstrators as well, who described their sufferings. "Our sufferings are unparalleled. The connection

has been off for 10 days. Our children are suffering as well," said Latifa Akhtar, a Salimpur resident.

Meanwhile, a clash broke out between two groups during the blockade on the highway around 5:00pm. A group of locals, equipped with sticks and iron rods, were reported to be chasing the demonstrators. Later, both the groups hurled bricks at each other.

Police later cleared the highway of the two groups, following which, the agitators backed out to Fojdarhat-Baizid Link Road area, resuming the traffic.

to be found through political discussion and diplomatic initiative."

Shaheen Anam, executive director of Manusher Jonno Foundation, stressed on a more proactive role from the international community. "The friction between Rohingyas and locals is on the rise. [But], repatriation discussions have been halted after the military coup in Myanmar."

"There has been little progress in ensuring justice for Rohingyas except some major decisions by ICJ and ICC [International Criminal Court] over the last couple

of years," said Manzoor Hasan, chairperson of ActionAid Bangladesh.

Farah Kabir, country director of ActionAid Bangladesh, said, "We have not seen any active and sustainable plan from the national and global leadership for peaceful repatriation. Therefore, reintegration in Myanmar remains a far cry."

A publication titled "Rohingyas in Myanmar and Bangladesh" -- authored by Dr Imtiaz Ahmed, professor of international relations and director of Centre for Genocide Studies -- was unveiled at the end of the event.

another 10-storey building from scratch, with a budget of Tk 138 crore.

"If there is any need for an administrative building, complete the existing one. This will save around a hundred crore," said Raihan Rayne, convener of "Jahangirnagar Against Corruption".

"We can't allow such wastage of money on unnecessary constructions. We want a permanent ban on this," said Anu Mohammad, former professor of economics at

JU. Project Director of JU Development Project Nasir Uddin said, "We are currently awaiting an investigation into the matter."

"The authorities never sought our suggestions before planning the new building's construction," said Prof Dil Afroza Begum, acting in-charge of University Grants Commission (UGC). This correspondent could not contact JU VC Prof Nurul Alam despite repeated attempts.

PBI takes 17th date to submit probe

A Dhaka court yesterday again asked PBI to submit -- by September 11 -- the probe report in a case filed against Bashundhara Group Managing Director Sayem Sobhan Anvir and seven others over the rape and murder of a college student in Gulshan.

Dhaka Metropolitan Magistrate Begum Yasmin Ara passed the order after IO Md Alauddin, also an inspector of PBI, failed to submit the report yesterday.

With the latest one, PBI took 17 dates to submit the report. Police recovered the body of the 21-year-old college student in a Gulshan flat on April 26 last year. Her elder sister on September 6 filed a case with Women and Children Repression Prevention Tribunal-8 of Dhaka.

from the coastline, Kamrul said.

It will keep the relevant authorities in loop with the position of fishing trawlers on Bangladesh territory.

This means every time a fishing vessel gets stranded in the middle of the sea during stormy weather, the coastguards can easily locate the trawlers with the available information.

When asked, he clarified that the boats won't help out fishers by providing cautionary weather signals, or informing them of stormy weather beforehand.

Anisur Rahman Talukder, deputy director of Barisal Divisional Fisheries Office, said if this device is installed, it will be easy to find the missing boats during storms.

FISHERS CONFUSED
It seems the fishers were not trained properly on the use of tracking devices, as most of them are apparently confused.

Fisher Md Babul said, "We have heard that if there is a cautionary signal at sea,

it will be known through this device, and it will also be possible to converse with the authorities through it while at sea."

President of Barisal Small Fishermen's Association Md Israel Pandit echoed the same.
