

ANTI-ISLAM REMARK

BJP leader arrested

Indian police arrested a BJP lawmaker yesterday for allegedly making derogatory comments against the Prophet Mohammad (PBHU), weeks after similar remarks from a top official embroiled the country in a diplomatic storm.

Raja Singh's words sparked outrage in the southern city of Hyderabad, where hundreds of people gathered on Monday night to demand the state politician be taken into custody.

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) member, who has cultivated a reputation for inflammatory speeches, had the same day published a video that local media reports said had made insulting remarks about the Islamic prophet.

A senior Telangana state police officer confirmed Singh's arrest to AFP.

His arrest comes weeks after a prominent BJP spokesperson ignited protests across India and its neighbours when she made a derogatory comment on the prophet on a TV debate programme.

1MDB GRAFT SCANDAL IN MALAYSIA

Ex-PM loses final appeal, sent to jail

Malaysia's top court ordered former prime minister Najib Razak to begin a 12-year prison sentence yesterday after upholding a guilty conviction on charges related to a multi billion dollar graft scandal at state fund 1Malaysia Development Berhad (1MDB).

The Federal Court ruling caps the stunning downfall of Najib, who until four years ago governed Malaysia with an iron grip and suppressed local investigations of the 1MDB scandal that has implicated financial institutions and high-ranking officials worldwide.

Investigators have said some \$4.5 billion was stolen from 1MDB - co-founded by Najib during his first year as prime minister in 2009 - and that over \$1 billion went to accounts linked to Najib.

Najib, wearing a dark suit and tie, sat in the dock as the verdict was read out. His wife, Rosmah Mansor, who is also facing corruption charges, and three children were seated behind him.

Security officials then gathered around the bespectacled former premier and he was later seen leaving court in a black car with police escort.

A court official and sources close to Najib said he was taken to Kajang Prison, about 40 km away from Kuala Lumpur.

"This is unprecedented. Najib will be remembered for his many firsts, the first prime minister to lose a general election, the first to be convicted," said Adib Zalkapli, Director at political risk consultancy BowerGroupAsia.

The British-educated son of Malay nobility held the premiership from 2009 to 2018, when public anger over the graft scandal brought election defeat, and dozens of corruption charges were lodged in following months.

Najib, 69, was found guilty by a lower court in July 2020 of criminal breach



Various recipients of the siphoned 1MDB funds, including a fugitive financier named Jho Low, used the money to buy luxury assets and real estate, a Picasso painting, a private jet, a superyacht, hotels, jewellery, and to finance the 2013 Hollywood film "The Wolf of Wall Street", US lawsuits have said.

Addressing the court moments before the final verdict was delivered, Najib said he was the victim of injustice.

"It's the worst feeling to have to realise that the might of the judiciary is pinned against me in the most unfair manner," Najib told the court.

Najib, who faces several more trials over the allegations, has consistently denied wrongdoing.

He could apply for a review of the Federal Court decision, though such applications are rarely successful. He can also seek a pardon from the king. If successful, he could be released without serving the full 12 year term.

But the conviction means Najib will lose his parliamentary seat and cannot contest elections.

GANG-RAPE DURING 2002 GUJARAT RIOTS

India SC to hear petition after release of convicts

India's Supreme Court will hold a hearing on a petition challenging the release last week of 11 men convicted of gang-rapeing a pregnant Muslim woman during Hindu-Muslim riots in 2002 in the western state of Gujarat.

Last Monday, authorities in the Panchmahals district of Gujarat released the men after considering the time they had served after their conviction in 2008 and their behaviour while jailed.

The Court verbally agreed yesterday to hear a Public Interest Litigation petition to reverse the state's remission order freeing the men, Kapil Sibal, an attorney representing a group of women seeking the reversal, told Reuters.

The women include Subhashini Ali, a member of the Communist Party of India, Revati Laul, an independent journalist, and Mahua Moitra, an MP from the opposition Trinamool Congress Party, Sibal said.

The petition holds that the men must serve their full life sentences.

The violence in Gujarat in 2002 was one of India's worst religious riots and more than 1,000 people died, most of them Muslims. During the riots, the 11 men, all Hindu, gang-rape a pregnant Muslim woman and her three-year-old daughter was among those 14 killed by a mob.

Current Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi was Gujarat's chief minister at the time of the riots.

US OFFICIAL ON NUKE DEAL

Iran has dropped some demands

Iran has dropped some of its main demands on resurrecting a deal to rein in Tehran's nuclear program, including its insistence that international inspectors close some probes of its atomic program, bringing the possibility of an agreement closer, a senior US official told Reuters.

The United States aims to respond soon to a draft agreement proposed by the European Union that would bring back the 2015 nuclear deal.

The official, speaking on condition of anonymity because of the sensitivity of the matter, said that although Tehran has been saying Washington has made concessions, Iran has dropped some of its key demands.

"They came back last week and basically dropped the main hang-ups to a deal," the official said. "We think they have finally crossed the Rubicon and moved toward possibly getting back into the deal on terms that President Biden can accept," the official added.

Iran's foreign ministry had no immediate comment.

Yesterday, EU's foreign policy chief Josep Borrell said most countries involved in nuclear talks with Iran agree with the EU proposal.

"Most of them agree, but I still don't have the answer from the United States, who I understand have to discuss it, and we expect during this week to receive an answer," Borrell said in an interview with Spain's national broadcaster TVE.

Earlier, State Department spokesman Ned Price said there was no guarantee a deal can be struck, saying "the outcome of these ongoing discussions still remains uncertain as gaps do remain."
