

Covid jabs for port city kids starts

Covid-19 vaccination for children aged between five and 11 started in Chattogram city yesterday, although the programme was supposed to start across the country today.

City Mayor Rezaul Karim Chowdhury inaugurated the programme at Chattogram Municipal Government Primary School in the morning.

Terming the programme "symbolic", Jaharlal Hazari, Chattogram City Corporation standing committee chairman for health affairs, told The Daily Star that the vaccination programme would formally start from today in the port city like elsewhere in the country.

"Today, the mayor of CCC inaugurated the symbolic programme to vaccinate a total of 300 children in a primary school," he said.

Hazari said a total of 4,00,000 children of the age group would be vaccinated under the programme in the city.

Need multi-sectoral engagement

Speakers tell event on TB Action Plan

Lack of multi-sectoral engagement and human resources have been responsible for the failure of the National TB Control Programme, leaving many tuberculosis patients undetected, said health officials at an event yesterday.

Each year, as many as 15 percent of the approximately 3.6 lakh TB patients in the country remain undetected, while many detected patients give up medications before getting cured completely, they mentioned at the launching event of the "Community, Rights and Gender Action Plan for TB" in a city hotel.

At the event, civil surgeons from 64 districts participated in the multiple focus group discussion session.

Tuberculosis is a bacterial infection spread through inhaling tiny droplets from the coughs or sneezes of an infected person. It mainly affects the lungs, but it can affect any part of the body, including the tummy (abdomen), glands, bones and nervous system.

Dr Rampad Roy, Sirajganj district civil surgeon, said, "A TB patient often faces discrimination due to misconception. We have stressed raising awareness regarding this through a multi-sectoral engagement."

The civil surgeons also discussed other problems in dealing with TB. With fewer staffs, a civil surgeon can not concentrate on controlling TB properly. The same thing happens in the case of an upazila-level health officer, they said.

According to the officials, DGHS operates the current TB control programme countrywide through the supervision of civil surgeons and the Upazila Health Family Welfare Officers (UHFWO).

Here, workers of 24 NGOs, including Brac, have been working in the fields under the UHFPO. As soon as they learn about any prospective TB patient, they take them to the Upazila Health Complex for a free TB screening through a Gene Expert machine.

"Sometime, a TB patient may be required to go through an X-Ray

test. However, this examination is not free of cost. The civil surgeons have asked for necessary logistics for this at the discussion," said DGHS Medical Officer (NTP) Dr Sayedul Bashir.

The other recommendations placed at the event by the civil surgeons and other health officials include integration of TB awareness issues in school health programmes and engagement of the Islamic foundation, ministry of industries, and municipalities and the city corporation authorities in the urban areas in this regard.

"The undetected TB patients spread the disease among others unknowingly. Unless the number of detection can be increased, the situation will turn more dangerous," said Health Minister Zahid Maleque during his chief guest's speech at the concluding session.

The minister said around 3.60 lakh people become affected with TB each year in the country. Of them, 3.07 lakh can be detected and around 44,000 TB patients die each year.

High taxes

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In many cases, taxes are taken from service providers and receivers of the same service, meaning that double taxation is taking place, the organisation said.

It was mentioned that Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation has to pay 15 percent VAT, 5 percent supply tax on purchased goods, and 5 percent on the revenue received.

Due to giving so much VAT and income tax in addition to paying salaries and allowances, the existence of the corporation has become impossible, the corporation added.

According to the committee, the authorities should take an integrated approach to keep taxes at a tolerable level in all the

related sectors, including the various service sub-sectors in the tourism industry.

The meeting recommended taking necessary measures by holding a meeting involving Dhaka north and south city corporations, finance ministry and National Board of Revenue.

About the obstacles in Cox's Bazar, lawmaker Obaidul said the 24-hour security system has been beefed up in the location.

"However, there is no means of recreation at night. This is the reason why tourists usually stay in the hotel area," he added.

The committee also recommended demolishing all old infrastructures in Cox's Bazar and building a modern tourist city.

HC verdict on seeking

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The organisation filed the petition challenging the legality of section 41 (l) of the Government Service Act 2018 which says that the law enforcers will have to take approval from the authorities concerned of the government for arresting any public service holders in connection with criminal cases before submitting the charge sheet.

Secretaries to the cabinet division, offices of

the president and prime minister, the ministries of public administration and law and Speaker of Jatiya Sangsad and ACC have been made respondents to the rule.

During hearing on the rule yesterday, the petitioner's lawyer Manzill Murshid told the HC court that the section of the law is discriminatory and contradictory to the constitution, as all citizens are equal in the eye of law under the constitution.

Don't dump sand

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Md Nur Alam Sheikh, convener of Bapa Mongla unit. While talking at the programme, farmers of Banishanta union claimed that croplands where sands are dumped can't be harvested for 8-10 years. They demanded that the authorities find alternative ways to dump sand.

Syeza Rizwana Hasan, chief executive of Bela, said the authorities should consider the locals' demand and find an alternative place to dump sand, if it really was an issue to only dredge the river.

Advocate Sultana Kamal said, "Development can't be a goal of a country. The aim should be improving the people's living standards."

"But the government only emphasised on development, ignoring people. The same situation is prevailing in Banishanta," she added.

She demanded the Mongla Port chairman's removal for defying the prime minister's instructions to "not waste any farmland".

Prothom Alo joint editor Sohrab Hossain also spoke at the event.

Implement DAP

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Adil said important issues like land resettlement and redevelopment have been included as well.

When building regulations were framed in 2006, there was a plan to formulate area-based floor area ratio (FAR), which has been included in this year's DAP, he said.

IPD believes that proper application of area-wise FAR will help manage population density as well as access to light and air for buildings and communities. It

will also reduce urban temperatures, he said.
