Rashid Khan

Rashid Khan was named ICC's T20I Player of the decade in 2020 and it is a testament to how he has carried forward the art of leg-spin in the modern era. Having played in T20 games across the globe, Rashid, through his many variations, is the flag-bearer of how leg spin continues to shape the shortest format of the game.



Babar Azam Pakistan skipper Babar Azam has continued to be an example for batters in world cricket, leading the ICC ODI and T20I rankings for batters. According to Shadab Khan, "he is the mixture of Cristiano Ronaldo and Lionel Messi" in cricket. And in current form, he's arguably the world's best. His balance and technique allow him to dictate terms against bowlers and his mental resilience sets him apart from most batters of his era. Babar will be the one to watch out for in any major

Shakib Al Hasan Even during dismal times for the Bangladesh national team in the T20I format, Shakib Al Hasan -- the newly appointed T20 skipper for the Tigers - has continued to evolve his own game.
