Three killed as part of rice mill hopper collapses

Three workers were killed after a shed of a hopper (carrying section) of a rice mill collapsed at Tangail's Gopalpur upazila on Sunday night. The accident took place at around 9:30pm at Ekota Rice Mills at Dubai area in the upazila. The deceased are Mohammad Arif (27), Nurul Islam (35) and Naimul Islam (30). Rafiqul Islam, station officer of Gopalpur Fire Service, said, "We've examined that the setting of the hopper was of low quality. The welding of the angles was weak. The workers were killed due to negligence of the mill authorities."

The factory has the capacity to produce 1,550 tonnes per day. This amount can easily meet the demand for urea fertiliser in 20 districts, according to the JFCL authorities.

FROM PAGE 5 than a hundred crore to alleviate citizen's sufferings, but problems keep increasing. In the last financial year, SCC did work worth Tk 209 crore to solve the city's waterlogging. Including this cost, the total expenditure

on waterlogging related projects in the last 12 years has been Tk 869 crore, according to city corporation documents. Contacted, Bidhayak Roy Chowdhury, chief executive officer of SCC, claimed that waterlogging in Sylhet city has reduced in recent years. "If it rains continuously, there will always be waterlogging as it takes some time for the water to drain." He said the SCC's work for regularly cleaning the canals and sewers is not bearing any fruit as the city dwellers continue to dump garbage in these places. "Besides, the Surma river's navigability has decreased. Our plea to the relevant government offices to dredge the river has repeatedly been ignored," he added. Sayeed Chowdhury, senior official at the Sylhet Meteorological Office, said, "The rainfall will continue till next Saturday, but the water amount will decrease over time."
