Sylhet mayor to visit US to inspect purchases; 6 officials awaiting permission to go along

government allowed the Sylhet City Corporation (SCC) mayor to visit a factory the SCC bought 20 vehicles for a waste management project. government

order, issued by the Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Cooperatives on August 30, mentioned that Bangla Trac Limited would bear the cost of the four-day trip to the factory of Caterpillar Inc.

But this borne cost will actually come out of the prices SCC paid for the vehicles. At a time when the government is trying to limit foreign trips of government

officials to save money, this issue has raised concerns. On top of this, SCC Chief Engineer

Nur Azizur Rahman, Executive Engineer Shamsul Islam, Assistant Engineer (Electrical) Joydeb Biswas, Sub-assistant Engineer (Mechanical) Jaberul Islam, Conservancy Officer Hanifur Rahman, and a joint secretary of the ministry are awaiting government sanction for the trip. Mahmud Chowdhury,

president of Sushashoner Jonno Nagorik's (Shujan) Sylhet chapter, said, "Although cost of such trips is covered by a company. it [company] includes the cost in the price of the products it's selling. So in actuality, taxpayers' money will be spent for this

"Furthermore, it doesn't make any sense for the mayor and a ministry official, who don't have the technical knowledge, to visit the factory," he said.

The trip was scheduled for August 27 to 30, but as the officials are still awaiting permission, the dates will be rescheduled, said SCC officials.

Spending Tk 17 crore for a project to modernise waste management, SCC recently purchased 15 compactor trucks, two wheel excavators, two bulldozers, and a wrecker of Caterpillar from Bangla Trac

'Stripped of our right to land'

Santals allege ruling party lawmaker 'grabbed' their land in Dinajpur

The Santal community in Dinajpur has brought allegations of land grabbing against an Awami League lawmaker and his uncle, in a press conference under the banner of "Movement for Santal Life and Land" in Jativa Press Club yesterday.

According to the allegations, Shibli Sadique, AL lawmaker from Dinajpur-6 and his uncle Delwar Hossen, also president of Jatiya Party's Dinajpur district unit, grabbed around 77 acres of the Santal community's land.

"Three graveyards belonging to the Mahali and Santal communities have been occupied by the uncle-nephew duo, where an amusement park and a residential building have been built," alleged the speakers at the event.

Ukil Hembrom, one of the victims of land grabbing, said he owned 33 decimals of land. "But I'm only left with five decimals," he said.

Altaf Ali, a resident of Dinajpur's Nawabganj, said the plot to grab the Santal community's land began in 2019. "During the pandemic, they grabbed his 300 decimals of land, he alleged.

Man who travelled on trains without tickets during govt job repays debts

Emdadul Haque of South Mourail area of Brahmanbaria town came multiple occasions as he could not posted a status mentioning the incident. to the booking assistant's room at Brahmanbaria Railway Station around 12:30pm on Monday.

Remorse has been a constant feeling for 61-year-old Emdadul Haque for the last couple of months. The reason is enough to come as a surprise for anyone in these times.

During his years as a government employee, Emdadul travelled several times without tickets on different trains on Dhaka-Chattogram and Dhaka-Sylhet railway routes.

Being driven by his conscience, Emdadul has recently paid all his dues after his retirement.

This rare occurrence went viral on social media as an instance of honesty

However, he kept records of all his due fares. These records helped him pay his dues upon retirement.

"There is no other way to repay this debt. So I gave the money directly to the railway. I don't know if I will be free from the liability but at least I will get my peace of mind.

"Ever since retirement, I have been suffering from guilt for travelling without tickets during my service years. The fares were paid after contacting the railway authorities," he

The story went viral on social media During his service, Emdadul travelled after Sohel Rana Bhuiyan, the admin

Brahmanbaria Railway Station Master Rafiqul Islam said the railway authorities overwhelmed as Emdadul has set such an example of honesty.

Didar Mollah, booking assistant at Brahmanbaria Railway Station, "Emdadul said. travelled times without a ticket during his time as a service holder. But he had been suffering from remorse ever since he retired."

"That is the reason he [Emdadul] contacted the railway himself. To get rid of the debt, he paid by buying a ticket worth Tk 2,530," said Didar.

Mahbubur said, "The demands are reasonable. We'll try to implement them as soon as possible."
