# Lalmonirhat idol artisans not happy

## Price of materials increased but selling price of idols has not

Things have not been faring well for almost 80 idol artisans at Lalmonirhat and Kurigram due to the price hike of idol-making Almost 350-400 materials. assistant artisans are suffering just the same.

They said the prices of materials such as clay, straw, bamboo, wood, and ropes increased but the selling prices of idols did not.

This year, Durga Puja will be held in 461 temples in Lalmonirhat and 513 temples in Kurigram.

Kurigram's idol artisan Jatindra Nath Pal (68) said each idol craftsman has four to five assistants working day and night. This year, they are making each Durga idol at Tk 20,000 to Tk

60,000.

"I used to collect clay from different places to make idols. No money had to be spent on that. Now we have to buy the clay," he

"This year I won't be able to make much profit by selling idols," he added.

Lalmonirhat's idol maker Pallab Chandra Roy (33) said each artisan is making 7-10 idols, without expecting any profit from the past two months.

"This profession is our ancestral duty as well. This is the only work I am proficient in and I have no choice but to continue," he said.

Artisan Sribas Chandra Roy (30) said last year, he was able to make a profit of Tk 10,000 - Tk 12,000.

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# 'A day of total chaos'

Vaccination centres for **English-medium students** see severe mismanagement

Mismanagement at Covid vaccination centres in some English-medium schools in the capital caused enormous suffering to vaccine-seeking students yesterday, making the health guidelines a total farce.

Students of some of the schools and their guardians alleged that the authorities of the school centres failed to ensure an environment that could assure the safety and security of the students, let alone maintain social distancing.

"I took my daughter to the school campus, used as the vaccination centre, around 8:45am. Once



I stepped inside the school, I saw a huge number of children and their guardians already cramming inside the premises. The place turned extremely humid and to some extent suffocating," said a guardian at a school in Dhanmondi.

"It was the only centre where all the eligible students of my daughter's school were given the first dose of the vaccine. As the day progressed, more and more guardians gathered inside the small premises, devoid of any crowd management," he said, preferring anonymity

Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) filed a case against former manager of country Bangladesh Biman Airlines's London Akhtaruddin Station Ahmed for misusing his power to cause the state airliner Tk 96.59 lakh loss. ACC Deputy Director Mohammad Sirajul Hoque filed the case with its integrated district office vesterday.

found "guilty" in Biman's internal investigation. ACC took over the matter in 2010.
