

## Four held over attack on journo Dorms closed

Police arrested four staffers after Haque filed a case with Kashiadanga Police Station accusing 19, of whom 14 were named.

The attack took place at noon when Tangim was driving his car to office and found the road blocked with a vehicle parked in front of the factory.

When Tangim protested, the factory staffers argued with him and at one stage assaulted him and damaged his car.

Tangim then called police who went to the spot and cordoned off the factory. Following this,

journalists also staged a sit-in in front of the factory protesting the assault.

RUJ president Rafiqul Islam alleged the factory was operating in a residential area without any valid document and its staffers were disturbing locals by parking trucks and pickup vans on a narrow stretch of the road. The journalists demanded a drive against the factory.

Following which, a mobile court team of the Directorate of National Consumer Rights Protection raided the factory and fined them Tk 2 lakh for various

irregularities including operating without any licence.

Hasan Maruf, an assistant director of Rajshahi district of Directorate of National Consumer Rights Protection, said the factory was functioning without any valid documents.

There was no quality control officer in the factory although it was manufacturing medicines, he said.

This correspondent could not get in touch with the factory officials for comments.

German and American scientists will come here to help find better solutions as well," he said.

As the news broke, the current and former students of the school started protesting in front of the school since Saturday night.

Sammo Rahman, a former student, said they also want the road to be widened for the development of the town, but they don't think there is a need to break the boundary wall of the historic school.

He also asked whether the town authorities are demolishing the structures of the local influential persons.

The school's headteacher Abdul Karim said, "The municipal authorities have already constructed a tin fence inside the boundary wall of the school even though nothing formal has been submitted yet."

Mayor SM Sirajul Haque Khan Alamgir said about 10 feet space inside the school belongs to the municipality, but

the decision to take only five feet space for road expansion was made to avoid any damage to the gate of the ancient school.

"The authorities are determined to recover all grabbed areas for widening the road for citizen's movement," he added.

Contacted, Dr Ataul Gani, deputy commissioner of Tangail, said he discussed the matter with the school's headmaster and the mayor and measured the area with a surveyor in presence of the assistant commissioner (land).

Jitendra Nath Roy of Tangua Kumarpura village said his niece Apo Rani, an RMG worker from the village, was returning home with her daughter after visiting her parents on July 29 afternoon.

"Apo's body was recovered from a nearby jute field. Her 10-year-old daughter lay unconscious next to her," said Jitendra. Apo's family members

have alleged that Apo was murdered after rape.

Police rescued the body and sent it to M Abdur Rahim Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Later, Apo's husband Mison Chandra Roy filed a murder and rape case with Khansama Police Station. PBI is currently investigating the incident, said Dinajpur SP Shah Ittekkar Ahmed.

Talking to this correspondent, the SP

said they have received the autopsy report.

"No evidence of rape was found. However, the report identified head injuries on her," he said.

"It has been 70 days since Apo died. However, police could make no headway in the case. Protesting this inaction, Hindu devotees have decided not to celebrate Puja this year," said Dhiman Das.

On the other hand, about 11,500 new applications were submitted and the government earned about Tk 8 lakh, reads a press release.

The money was transacted cashless through a mobile wallet and internet banking system.

An individual for every application has to pay

a total of Tk 1,170 for mutation that include Tk 20 court fee, Tk 50 notice issuance fee, Tk 1,000 record revision fee and Tk 100 ledger fee.

Earlier, the land ministry ordered to not accept fees in cash after September 30. It takes a maximum 28 working days for mutation after the submission of application.

submit their swab sample for RT-PCR test at the DNCC Covid-19 Dedicated Hospital in Dhaka's Mohakhali.

Under the government arrangement, any outgoing Bangladeshi passengers can avail of the service at a cost of Tk 100.

Besides, the same service is available in 16 other districts under government arrangement while there are a total of 70 private laboratories allowed to provide similar RT-PCR test service at a cost of Tk 2,500 each.

Meanwhile, one female Covid-19 patient, aged above 60 years, died at a hospital in Rangpur, said the press release.

With this, the total number of fatalities due to

Covid-19 reached 29,369. A total of 535 new cases were detected in the past 24 hours till 8:00am yesterday.

Against a total of 3,727 tests, the positivity rate was 14.35 percent. Meanwhile, a total of 476 Covid-19 patients recovered in the same 24 hours yesterday. The recovery rate was more than 97 percent.

While visiting Ramakrishna Mission puja mandap in the capital on the Mahasaptami day of Durga Puja, the minister urged all to remain alert to maintain peace and harmony.

"A vested quarter wants to shift the responsibility to the government after carrying out attacks on the Hindu community," he said. "The puja committee told me that none gets punished for communal

attacks... many criminals were brought to justice under the Sheikh Hasina government.

Even, members of her own party (AL) have been sent to jail. Perpetrators will not be spared if they carry out attacks on Hindu temples, homes and puja mandaps," he said.

The AL general secretary said the national election is approaching and ahead of the polls, a vested quarter, by conducting attacks on the Hindu community,

wants to inform the Indian government that those were carried out by AL.

"So, remain alert against the evil force," he added.

Asking BNP not to do politics over the Durga Puja festival, Quader said, "Along with the ruling party, the opposition party also has a role to play in keeping the puja peaceful."

Urging the Hindu community members not to get panicked, he said the AL leaders and activists will alert to this end.
