

# Smart ways to arrange furniture



Arranging furniture can be tricky. One needs to consider multiple variables while setting the room. For instance, the purpose of the room, the lighting, how spacious they want the room to be, how many walls the room already has and so on.

Here are some ways to arrange rooms to fulfil the purpose of the room and to make it more welcoming.

## Creating a conversation space

For conversation spaces, we often consider the living room where guests can sit and feel comfortable. It is crucial that this area is inviting, easy for conversation and welcoming. The first furniture pieces to consider are chairs and sofas. Ideally, the chairs should be placed facing one another such that anyone seated anywhere can easily converse with everyone. Additionally, the layout should be such that there is a centre table and other coffee tables at arm's length to keep drinks or snacks on. The centre table could be decorated with ornaments and trinkets to brighten the space. Furthermore, the chairs should be placed so that there are no walls obstructing interactions, not too close to

light sources and that no one feels isolated.

One might also consider what kind of chairs are used in conversation spaces. Comfortable sofas and chairs should be placed in this room considering the softness, depth and height of the chairs to ensure maximum comfort. For tables, its length should be equal or lower than the height of the chairs.

## Increasing efficiency for home office rooms

We sometimes keep a room separate for working or studying. For this layout, it is important to keep in mind that the room should not be too crowded and it should promote productivity.

A desk with sufficient drawers and storage room is often the centre of the room. Picking out a desk large enough for computers, laptops and other work material ought to be taken into consideration along with the size of the room. To accompany the desk, a desk lamp is a wise and an aesthetic addition. To ensure sufficient lighting, wall mounted lights can look appealing. One might also consider putting plants in hanging pots, vertical storage spaces to

maximise organisation, a comfortable chair and other necessary furniture. Additionally, putting up motivation posters and portraits in moderation can add some flow to the room.

## Setting up a recreation room

A recreation space or children's playroom must include comfortable seats. The best part is that there is no need to make the layout too intricate or complicated. Fur rugs, bean bags, floor cushions or even a huge stuffed animal might be used for seating. It is also crucial to take the items' size and height into account while choosing the proper playroom furniture. One might consider furniture that, with little to no assistance from anyone else, the child can easily climb, grab or crawl through. Therefore, when choosing furniture pieces, take into account your child's age and how big they are now (and will likely be in a few years). Be sure to include storage space like drawers and baskets to keep the room tidy.

## An inviting dining area

The central purpose of a dining area is to enjoy meals with friends and family. Setting up a long rectangular or a round

table is ideal. It would be convenient to buy a furniture set for the dining room with complimentary chairs. The set should match with the walls and be of an inviting neutral colour. Additionally, lighting is crucial for this area as well. The best option for creating an inviting atmosphere is warmer lighting, such as soft white. For multipurpose dining rooms, one may also take into account colour-changing light bulbs or numerous coloured light bulbs. Adding shelves, showcases and other furniture accessories can highlight the room further.

It is important to consider the room's purpose and to set the furniture layout. Before investing in the appropriate furniture, consider drafting out the layout on graph paper or by using an online tool to help visualise what the room could look like. All in all, investing in quality furniture to accentuate the room and make it more inviting and cosier will make the entire house a home for everyone.
