It has now been narrowed down to around 30 to 40 feet, said sources at the land office.
Officials of Water Development Board in Jhenidah have recently made a list of eight grabbers. They are - Motiar Rahman, Ishahak Ali, Sirazul Islam, Liakot Ali, Mizanur Rahman, Mofiz Uddin, Afsar Ali and Md Abdul Ali. All of them are residents of Singdha village. Of them, Motiar Rahman has excavated a pond at the village grabbing the riverbank, according to the list. Contacted, Motiar denied the allegations and said, "I did not encroach the riverbank. I have excavated a pond on my own land."
Md Abdul Ali said, "I have excavated a pond on my ancestral land. If the government wants, they can resurvey the land. If any portion of my pond lies on the riverbank, I will leave the land."
The correspondent contacted the others on the

list, who also came up with similar statements.
Meanwhile, environmentalists demanded immediate government action to evict grabbers to protect the river.
"The list of eight grabbers is a farce. Several hundreds of people have encroached the riverbank. We demand a proper list and drives to evict the grabbers," said Shibu Pada Biswas, convener of Nadi Bachao Andolon.
Bangladesh Poribesh Andolon (Bapa) general secretary Sharif Jamil said the riverbank should be much wider. "If any structure is set up within this area, it should be evicted."
Contacted, Jhenidah Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue) Rajibul Islam Khan said, "We will soon conduct drives to evict the illegal structures. Besides, the government has taken a new project to re-excavate the river."

and the cameras themselves were damaged during city corporation's development works.
"With our own funds, we have repaired around 50 cameras. However, due to the lack of a maintenance budget, the licence of the facial and number-plate recognition software has expired," he said.
"We have contacted the authorities concerned for a special budget allocation for the maintenance and renewal of the software. We also urged the city corporation to repair the damaged cables."
When asked, SCC's Ruhul Alam said during the city's road expansion work, some electrical pillars of Power Development Board needed to be reallocated, and cameras and their cables were damaged in the process.
"As we don't have sufficient budget, we have requested the mayor's intervention in this regard," he added.
Mohammad Mohidur Rahman Khan, manager of BCC (security operations) and project director of Digital Sylhet City, said, "After completing two components under the project, we managed the maintenance for a year, and then, the responsibility went to the authorities concerned (SMP and SCC) as per the signed MoU."

can create good educational institutions, hospitals, employment opportunities, and communication systems in those areas, people will go and live there," he said, adding that there is no initiative for this in the DAP.
"In the DAP, a FAR of 1.5 to 2 has been given for the surrounding areas, which is unacceptable," Iqbal mentioned.
Chief Executive Officer of Sheltec Sharif Hossain Bhuyian said the new FAR values will negatively impact the construction of buildings.

Adil Mohammad Khan, former general secretary of Bangladesh Institute of Planners, said, "We must keep in mind, higher FAR values, in general, only exacerbate the prevailing disparity between landowners and landless urbanites in Dhaka city."
"Far values above 1 to 1.5... will create disparity and discrimination. It will pave the way for landowners to start a predatory real-estate business, which has already been witnessed in Dhaka city."
He said that is why for plot-based housing development, even in cities like Singapore, the FAR

value is around 1 to 1.5, or the authorities allow a maximum of two-storey buildings.
Rajuk Chairperson Anisur Rahman Miah told The Daily Star that authorities prepared this DAP keeping long term plans in mind. The FAR values have decreased for densely populated areas.
About the middle class, he said there are some areas in Uttara where they can buy flats at relatively low prices.
Talking about peripheral areas, the chairperson said, "In those areas, FAR values are not based on the entire location. If the plot is big,

the FAR will be higher."
"For example, if four people own separate plots and combine them to construct a building jointly, then the FAR will be higher. Hence, we are encouraging big plots," he added.
Although the first DAP was gazetted in 2010, the authorities could not implement it due to several reasons, such as lack of necessary, effective initiatives; weak law enforcement to prevent unauthorised construction; shortage of resources; lack of coordination among stakeholders; and inconsistencies in proposed policies.

of the International Centre for Climate Change and Development (ICCCAD), mentioned that today's youth should not just focus on the practicalities but also the right actions regarding the Global North to compensate climate-vulnerable countries in the Global South.
Public, private, and non-profit sector leaders Dr Gowher Rizvi, Nahim Razzaq, Yasir Azman, Asif Saleh, and Robert Chatterton Dickson spoke about intergenerational collaboration and the need to act with urgency to fight climate change.
Grameenphone CEO Yasir Azman pointed out the present crucial

situation of climate vulnerability of the world, especially in Bangladesh, and asked corporate houses and global leaders to come forward in this regard.
Dr Gowher Rizvi, advisor to the prime minister, delivered his speech virtually.
Later, Brac Executive Director Asif Saleh, British High Commissioner to Bangladesh Robert Chatterton Dickson, and Dr Saleemul Huq participated in the discussion as panelists.
"Climate change is the biggest crisis facing humanity today. To address a complex challenge like climate change, we will have to work globally and at scale," CEO Dickson.
GYLC CEO Ejaz Ahmad, said GYLC is being

launched as a global organisation to mobilise the youth - especially from the Global South - to tackle the climate crisis.
"Our mission is to expand the youth's knowledge about climate science, equip them with leadership skills to take individual and collective action and enable them to launch businesses that contribute to climate mitigation or adaptation," he said.
He also mentioned that Khulna has been chosen as the summit venue as it is one of Bangladesh's most climate-vulnerable regions.
"The youth participating in the summit will undertake mangrove plantation in the coastal belt to promote locally-led climate adaptation and highlight the importance of mangroves, which are critical for human beings as well as for biodiversity," he added.
To empower the youth in climate action, 10 delegates at the summit will receive a grant of USD 1,000 each

to implement their climate mitigation or adaptation project.
The organisation's chairman Neal Walker, said, "Young people not only demand climate change action but they also lead the way."
"Leadership, innovation and entrepreneurship all offer avenues of success. But we need action at a global level. Our organisation can transform the idealism, ideas and talents of youth all over the world into results," he added.
A Global Youth Climate Summit team also made a field visit yesterday to an eco-friendly village in the coastal belt of Khulna, where summit participants learnt about locally-led adaptation projects involving farming, water treatment and climate mitigation projects involving solar energy.
Yesterday, on the second day of the conference, participants also visited a model village of forest dwellers in Dakop upazila.
