

Dengue cases keep shattering records

Over 1,000 patients hospitalised in a day

With 1,034 new dengue patients were admitted to different hospitals across the country in the last 24 hours till yesterday morning, the highest in a single day. The total number of cases has crossed the 31,000 mark.

According to Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), one dengue patient died yesterday. The death toll has risen to 113, while total cases are now 31,064. Some 3,492 dengue patients, 1,206 are from outside Dhaka, are still undergoing treatment. Experts have urged authorities to conduct extensive drives to identify clusters of Aedes mosquitoes immediately. According to DGHS findings, dengue infections are highest among people aged over 20, while people aged between 40 and 80 are mostly dying of the disease. Of the deaths, most died within three days of being admitted to a hospital.

During a week-long special drive, mobile courts of Dhaka North City Corporation (DNCC) yesterday fined homeowners a total of Tk 6.93 lakh and filed eight cases, as authorities found Aedes mosquito larvae at their premises.

Freak accident ends the lives of 3 friends

Three friends were killed when a launch's water tank fell on them after the vessel hit a bridge in Shariatpur's Gosairhat upazila early yesterday. The deceased are Tanzil (23) of Gosairhat, Sagar Ali (23) of Jamalpur, and Shakil Ahmed (23) of Tangail, said Gosairhat Police Station Officer-in-Charge Aslam Sikder. Tanzil was supposed to get married today, and he was going home with his two friends for the event, the OC said. The incident took place in Jayantia river around 4:30am, when Swarnadeep, was travelling by a launch towards Shariatpur's Damudya upazila, said the official. "When the launch was passing beneath a bridge, the water tank hit the structure. Then, the tank fell on the passengers who were sleeping nearby, leaving three dead on the spot and two injured," the OC said. One of the injured was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital, he said. Police detained two launch staffers.

US to support Bangladesh for energy security

The US has promised to support Bangladesh to achieve its energy access goals, which include energy security and production of clean energy. It also wants to help through the Clean EDGE Asia Initiative, which aims to grow sustainable and secure clean energy markets throughout the Indo-Pacific. US Special Presidential Envoy for Climate John Kerry said this in a letter to Foreign Minister AK Abdul Momen on October 13, a foreign ministry statement said yesterday. The letter was sent a day after Momen wrote to John Kerry, informing Bangladesh's decision to join Global Methane Pledge, a US and EU-led joint initiative to curb global methane emission. In the letter, Momen reminded Kerry of the latter's assurance of supporting Bangladesh with critical technologies to mitigate adverse effects on the productivity in agriculture and livestock sectors. John Kerry said the US State Department's Bureau of Energy Resources looks forward to establishing a new partnership between Bangladesh's Power Grid Company and US' Pacific Northwest Laboratory to improve operations and planning to ensure grid stability and reliability for supporting increased use of renewables. It also wants to schedule a date to launch new collaboration on carbon capture, utilisation and storage as well as blue hydrogen development with Petrobangla.
