

# MYMENSINGH MEDICAL COLLEGE HOSPITAL Illegal parking a lingering menace

Illegal parking of vehicles on both sides of an important road on Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) premises is obstructing entrance to the hospital.

The vehicles, mainly cars, CNG-run auto-rickshaws and minibuses of hospital staffers and different pharmaceutical companies, occupy this busy road for several hours during office time, said hospital sources.

This practice has been going on for years, they added.

The road leads to the hospital store and Institute of Nuclear Medicine and Allied Sciences (INMAS). On the suggestion of doctors, hundreds of patients from different areas of Mymensingh visit INMAS for better test results at a comparatively less cost, said the sources.

"It's the only institute in Mymensingh and so the patients from Mymensingh, Jamalpur, Sherpur, Tangail, Netrakona and Kishoreganj are referred here for quality tests and reports," said Dr Motiur Rahman Bhuiyan, president of Bangladesh Medical Association, Mymensingh unit.

Tests, including, blood and hormone test, ultra-sonogram, ECG are conducted at the institute. If the patients' attendants can't move easily, it's difficult for them to get the tests done in due time, he added.

"But due to the illegal parking, we have to struggle often to take patients to the



institute on time," said Golam Murtaza, an attendant of a patient.

Even trolley carriers, who have to take medicines and other hospital related commodities to and from the hospital store face trouble due to space constraint during office hours. On different occasions, they informed hospital officials about it, but they didn't take any steps to minimise it, said a trolley carrier.

Besides, private ambulances, which remain parked at the hospital's emergency entrance, create more obstacles, said Asma Razzaq, an attendant from Netrokona.

CNG and battery-run auto-rickshaws are also seen parked near the emergency gate entrance to get trips for different destinations, said Asma Khatun, an attendant from Jamalpur.

Dr Wayezuddin Farazi, deputy director of MMCH, said they have already initiated a drive to stop such illegal parking, including private ambulances on hospital premises to ensure smooth movement of patients and attendants.

SQ Chowdhury, one of the top BNP leaders, was executed for committing crimes against humanity in the 1971 Liberation War.

During the protest, the activists shouted slogans - "There is no place for razakar's wife and children in the land of Bangabandhu".

They also hung a sign which said "Razakar Bari [the house of razakar]" at the entrance of Good's Hill, the house of SQ

Chowdhury. During the programme, police cordoned off the entire area adjacent to Good's Hill at Gani Bakery intersection.

Speakers said during the 1971 war, many freedom fighters were tortured at Good's Hill by razakars, local collaborators of the then Pakistani occupation army.

They demanded that the government confiscate all the properties of war criminals' family members.

The seized fertiliser includes 320 sacks of DAP and 194 sacks of TSP. Each of the sacks contains 50kg of fertiliser.

The government sells per sack of DAP fertiliser at Tk 700 and TSP at Tk 1,000 to dealers who are instructed to retail each sack of DAP at a maximum Tk 800 and TSP at Tk 1,100, said officials.

Although earlier, I was apparently healthy, these unnecessary surgeries disrupted my normal life. Now, I cannot even simply walk or get on public transport," he said.

money from the country's forex reserves is being used for development activities, imports, and the people's welfare.

"Many people are questioning where the money from the forex reserves is going. The money goes to Payra Port. It is being used to purchase food and fertiliser for the people. It is also being used for imports and the people's welfare. No one is misappropriating the money," she said.

said, even a year ago, the country had USD 48 billion in forex reserves. Due to spending from the reserves, the amount now stands at USD 27 billion. The country may face a severe economic disaster next year.

"The reserves have been used to invest in airport projects, Payra seaport, and investments in Sri Lanka. In fact, reserve money has been looted," he said.

Quader said, "We supported Awami League in the 2008 elections to save the country from the corruption of Hawa

Bhaban. But Awami League did not keep its word."

"At first, it thought Jatiya Party is its affiliated organisation, then a servant, and now a slave. It wants to control everything. We don't want to be controlled by anyone. We will not be slaves to anyone," he said.

Quader claimed that a conspiracy has started to weaken Jatiya Party again.

Without mentioning any name, he said the conspirators are trying to split the party and create divisions.

government bodies have to come forward to make the DAP a reality," he added.

The minister said a team led by Salman F Rahman, adviser to the prime minister, discussed the DAP for two hours, agreeing with most of the plan's details, with a suggestion to correct 10 percent of the provisions.

Tajul said they incorporated the idea of block-based housing to save open spaces. This provision accrued some criticism from citizens. "The idea is not new. It's been in practice globally. We all just conformed to the

global standard."

The minister also underscored the need to address the reasons behind people's influx into the capital. "People come to the city for education, medical treatment and jobs. If we are able to ensure such facilities at the district level, the inflow will decline."

Ishrat Islam, dean of architecture and planning at Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BuEt), said the DAP has suggested five water-centric parks for Dhaka.

Ashrafur Alam, planner of Rajuk and project director of the DAP, said

as part of decentralisation, the DAP has divided the city into six metropolitan regions. Six new parks have been suggested, which will make the city liveable.

Nasir Uddin, member of planning of Rajuk, said Dhaka could be turned into a liveable city using the DAP. For that to happen, cooperation from all government bodies is needed.

Md Anisur Rahman Miah, chairperson of Rajuk; Anisul Hoque, associate editor of Bangla daily Prothom Alo; and Nazrul Islam, chairperson of Nagar Ghesona Kendro, spoke among others.

300 structures and most of them are business establishments," he said.

The drive will continue today, he said.

Dr Rafiqul Islam Mollah, president of Savar Nodi-o-Poribesh Unnayan Parishad, told The Daily Star, "We welcome this initiative to evict the encroachers although it has been taken after a long time."

Meanwhile, pointing to Savar municipality mayor Haji Abdul Goni's establishments on

the riverbank next to Namabazar bridge, Rafiqul said, "We request the authorities concerned not to spare any influential people."

However, Goni repeatedly claimed that he has no illegal structures there.

Meanwhile, the district administration, during the drive, found that all the illegal structures have legal electricity connection and municipality holding numbers.

One Motaleb Mia said he used to pay electricity bill

and municipality tax for his structure built before 1980.

About such holding number, the mayor said, "I don't know how they got it. We will look into the matter."

Abul Kalam Azad, general manager of Dhaka Palli Bidyut Samity-3, said normally electricity connection is given following submission of land ownership papers. "Since the connection was provided a long time ago, it is not possible to tell the details without checking the files."

## 3 HC judges kept away

Advocate Khurshid Alam Khan, an SC lawyer and editor of Dhaka Law Reports, told this correspondent that names of the three judges are not included in the daily cause-list of the HC, and therefore, they cannot perform judicial activities.

However, they are getting all relevant benefits, including salaries and transport costs, and are using the SC flag on their cars, he said.

Khurshid, also chief counsel for the Anti-Corruption Commission, termed the move of excluding them as

unprecedented. "I've never seen such a situation in my 30 years of profession."

The judges were asked to refrain from judicial activities on August 22, 2019.

After they were informed, the judges sought leave from the authorities concerned, SC Spokesperson Mohammad Saifur Rahman said in a press statement on that day, without mentioning any reasons.

The statement also did not disclose the names of the judges and why authorities are conducting the inquiry.
