

Early flood warning can save

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another between Melbourne University and Dhaka University, for research and development on this front.
The state minister said during this year's flood in Sylhet division, the government could successfully evacuate around 9.5 lakh people in 12 hours and also provided 60 large multipurpose accessible rescue boats to flood-prone districts from 2020 till May this year,

which were useful during this year's flood.
A cell could be established at the disaster management ministry which can play the lead role and coordinate the dissemination of early warning for floods, said Arif Abdullah Khan, programme specialist at UNDP Bangladesh.
While disseminating warning messages, it should be ensured that they reach marginalised groups, said Dilruba Haider, programme specialist at

UN Women Bangladesh.
Colin McQuistan, head of climate and resilience at Practical Action UK, joined the roundtable virtually.
Mahjabeen Khaled, secretary general of Bangladesh Parliamentarians' Caucus on Migration and Development; Golam Mortoza, head of The Daily Star's Bangla section; and Mostak Hussain, director (humanitarian) at Save the Children Bangladesh, spoke at the event among others.

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are included in the 8th Five-Year plan, only two are budgeted," noted the report. "Of the 48 projects in the 8th Five-Year plan and 19 in the 9th Five-Year Plan, only 16 have development project proposals in place, and/or feasibility studies that are ongoing or have been completed. Overall, the institutional capacity to prepare bankable projects is relatively low."
Estimates from this year show that women-led households are disproportionately affected more when adapting to climate change. While

the cost of adapting is 15 percent of the total household expenditure for male-headed households, it is as much as 30 percent for families headed by a woman. The report was launched at a city hotel, where John Roome, regional director of South Asia Sustainable Development of World Bank, presented the findings, with Planning Minister MA Mannan as chief guest of the event.
