

Protect residence of Ramnath Biswas

Speakers tell seminar

Eminent citizens yesterday demanded that the government protect the house of world traveler and travelogue writer Ramnath Biswas at Baniachang upazila in Habiganj.

They were speaking at a seminar organised by the Habitat Restoration and Conservation Committee of World Traveler Ramnath Biswas Bishwa Sahitto Kendra in Dhaka.

Mofidul Hoque, trusty of Liberation War Museum, Shahriar Kabir president of Ekattorer Ghatok Dalal Nirmul Committee, and former additional secretary Jalal Ahmed were present at the event.

Mofidul Hoque said, "I first read Ramnath in the 60's, when I was in school. Ramnath traveled the world. He went to Africa and saw their struggles in his own eyes. After that, he became an anti-colonialist."

Shahriar Kabir said, "We know about many travel story writers in Bangla literature, but what makes Ramnath different is his humble background. He did not have higher education, nor did he owned enormous wealth. What he had was courage and boundless curiosity."

Stating that Ramnath Biswas' residence is in the possession of an Al Badr family (local collaborators of Pakistan Army in 1971), Shahriar Kabir said, "In independent Bangladesh, it is a matter of shame."

Historian Ahsanul Kabir presented the keynote paper at the seminar.

He said, "Initiatives should be taken now to keep his memories alive. Textbooks should include his biography."

Travelogue writer Ashrafuzzaman Uzzal, convener of Habitat Restoration and Conservation Committee, presided over the seminar.

Baul Bashiruddin Sarkar sang his own song on Ramnath at the event.

JAMUNA EROSION IN SIRAJGANJ

Homes lost, families displaced

Following sudden erosion, at least 20 houses were devoured in the Jamuna river in Chongacha union of Sirajganj Sadar in the last 24 hours till yesterday afternoon. Besides, more than 30 families were forced to leave their home and take shelters elsewhere fearing similar fate.

The Water Development Board has dumped sand bags by the river bank to tame the river, which they claim is already improving the situation.

Abdur Razzak of the village said

The river suddenly started flowing above the danger level on Sunday morning. After a few hours, rock and soil started wearing away along 150 metres of the river bank.

The situation deteriorated gradually, said Chongacha union parishad chairman Mohammad Ali Jinnah.

Ronojit Kumar Sarkar, assistant

engineer of Sirajganj WDB, said, "We have started dumping sand bags in the affected area from Sunday afternoon. Things are already improving."

"Work is underway to construct a permanent river protection embankment. Villagers won't have to worry about erosion again once the project gets completed," he claimed.

'It's for EC to decide'

Law minister on allowing foreign observers in polls

Law Minister Anisul Huq yesterday said the Election Commission will decide whether foreign observers will be allowed to observe the next parliamentary elections.

The law minister said this while speaking to media after a meeting with Canadian High Commissioner Lilly Nicholls at his ministry office in Secretariat.

He said they discussed different issues including the elections, DSA and Data Protection Act.

The government will hold dialogues with the stakeholders for two or three times more before formulating the Data Protection Act, he said, adding that the act will be formulated to protect the data, not to control the data of people.

The minister said he requested the Canadian government to find out an alternative way to send Bangabandhu's convicted killer Nur Chowdhury back to Bangladesh, as their law does not permit sending such person back to those countries where execution of death sentence is effective.

She said she will discuss the matter with her government, said the minister. Earlier, the Canadian envoy told the media that they discussed 50 years of friendship between the two countries as well as areas of mutual cooperation.

She did not allow any question.

Unite to oust govt

BNP leaders urge activists in Rajshahi

BNP central leaders in Rajshahi urged the party leaders and activists to forget rivalry and work together to topple the government.

The BNP leaders came up with the remarks while addressing a coordination meeting yesterday, on the occasion of Rajshahi divisional rally on December 3.

BNP's national standing committee member Iqbal Hasan Mahmud Tuku was present as chief guest at the meeting while BNP chairperson's adviser Mizanur Rahman Minu chaired it.

BNP's Rajshahi divisional organising secretary Ruhul Quddus Talukder Dulu conducted the meeting.

Presidents, general secretaries, conveners and other leaders of eight district committees of the division and Rajshahi City committee attended the meeting.

Tuku said, "The people of the country fought the Liberation War to achieve the right to vote. That right has been taken away by the government."

Referring to BNP's internal disputes, Dulu said it would be difficult to do politics if the Rajshahi divisional public meeting on December 3 lopped due to party members' quarrels.
