The recent exam questions that hurt religious sentiments and demeaned women and one writer are unacceptable, said civil-society members, demanding an end to such "anarchy" in the education system.

The questions were prepared for HSC and equivalent

In a joint statement, signed by 24 eminent citizens, they said a universal, secular and science-based education system has not been established even after 50 years of independence, rather a regressive system has been set up.

People are now talking about whether teachers have the skills to prepare creative questions. "Both teachers and students need to acquire creative skills," they observed.

Pointing to the recent discussions on question papers, they said it is high time to think about the whole education system, not just the competency of those who prepare questions. "The demand of dropping Charles Darwin's evolution theory from the curriculum has also concerned us. This will hinder science study and free thinking. It will push the country backwards, towards communalism,' reads the statement.

2 die as picnic bus hits tree in Ctg

Two people died after a picnic bus crashed into a roadside tree on Chattogram-Cox's Bazar highway in Lohagara upazila of Chattogram early yesterday.

The deceased were identified as Avijit (34) and Shakhawat Siddique (35).

The accident occurred around 3:00am when the Cox's Bazar-bound bus from EPZ area of Chattogram hit a roadside tree on the highway, said Sumon Rahman, sub-inspector of Dohazari Highway Police Station.

The two passengers were crushed under wheels of the bus after falling off the vehicle following the crash, he added.

They were rushed to Upazila Sadar Hospital where doctors declared them dead.

Police seized the bus, said the SI.

BNP doing politics over IMF loan Says Quader

Awami League General Secretary Obaidul Quader yesterday said BNP's political bankruptcy has reached such a low point that the party is now doing politics over the loan of the International Monetary Fund (IMF).

"A few days ago, they (BNP leaders) conspired and presented false and fabricated information on Bangladesh's economy to the IMF asking it not disburse loan (to Bangladesh). Again, when the IMF is going to provide loans, they are now making misleading remarks," he said in a statement.

Quader, also the road transport and bridges minister, said BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir made unrealistic comments on the IMF loan, raising questions intentionally.




