where everyone loves bedazzled designs, it is hard to make people see the real beauty that traditional designs hold. But I am sure, this collection will help people see how versatile our traditional designs can be."

Maheen Khan is also spot on when it comes to detailing, it is her forte. Giving attention to minute details is what made the evening a perfect treat for those in attendance. Her choreographer, the talented Sonia Yeasmin Isha complemented her hard work flawlessly and the pair pulled off one of the best fashion shows in town this season.
