Amiya Prapan Chakraborty (Arka) founded Dhrubotara Youth Development Foundation (DYDF) in 2011 which has grown into one of the largest spaces for the youth across Bangladesh to engage in social activities, volunteerism and policy-level dialogue.



Ahmed Imtiaz Jami

Jami founded Obhizatrik Foundation in 2010 with a small free school for the underprivileged. Its cornerstone project, "Shokkhom", started in 2016, And created 23 different small business models for donors to fund. This ranges from Transportation based businesses, Small and Medium Enterprises, Agro-based business and Livestock business and can cost as little as Tk.10,000 to start up. All participants in Shokkhom start earning by 6-8 months of onboarding.



Esrat Karim Eve

After an internship at the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, Esrat returned to Bangladesh to contribute to the welfare of the country, founding AMAL with a few friends. Today, her Foundation's contribution towards education, disaster support, women and children empowerment, and healthcare has granted her national and international recognitions, including a place in Forbes' 30 under 30 Asia in 2020.



Tawhida Shiropa

Tawhida Shiropa founded "Moner Bondhu" to start creating awareness and breaking stigma on mental health issues and treatment, while providing solutions, treatment and quality mental healthcare service to those in need of it. Moner Bondhu is a challenging undertaking in a country where people ignore mental illness and consequently suffer the effects of poor mental health care services, societal taboo and lack of awareness.

Ratul Dev founded Gen Lab in 2015 with a vision to engage youth across the world for peaceful, tolerant and inclusive communities.
