

Dr IPD Advisor Akter Mahmud said, "Playgrounds enhance our socialisation skills. How can we expect a self-

centred generation to lead There are around 795 in us in building the country?"

Javed Omar Belim Golla, a former cricketer of the Bangladesh national cricket team, said most areas where they grew up playing sports in old Dhaka do not exist now.

"We failed to save the playgrounds despite protesting. How will our children live a healthy life if they do not get the opportunity to play in the neighbourhood?" he said.
