

# ROHINGYA CRISIS A TIMELINE

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| <b>1978</b><br>May          | More than <b>200,000</b> Rohingyas fled to Bangladesh.                                                                                     |
| <b>1978</b><br>July 9       | Bangladesh and Myanmar signed an agreement to repatriate the Rohingyas.                                                                    |
| <b>1991-92</b>              | Around <b>200,000</b> Rohingyas returned to Arakan.                                                                                        |
| <b>1992</b>                 | <b>2,50,277</b> Rohingyas entered Bangladesh.                                                                                              |
| <b>1993-1997</b>            | Some <b>230,000</b> refugees returned to Arakan.                                                                                           |
| <b>2016</b>                 | Some <b>87,000</b> Rohingya people fled to Bangladesh following clashes between Arakan Rohingya Salvation Army (ARSA) and Myanmar Army.    |
| <b>2017</b><br>August 25-31 | Around <b>940,000</b> Rohingyas fled to Bangladesh following massive violence in Rakhine State.                                            |
| <b>2017</b><br>November 23  | Bangladesh and Myanmar sign repatriation deal.                                                                                             |
| <b>2019</b><br>November 11  | Gambia files a lawsuit at the International Court of Justice (ICJ) accusing Myanmar of genocide against the Rohingyas.                     |
| <b>2020</b><br>Dec 4        | <b>2,500</b> Rohingyas relocated outside of Cox's Bazar at Bhasan Char, an island in Naikhal.                                              |
| <b>2022</b><br>March 21     | The US officially declares the 2017 violence constituted genocide where there was clear evidence of an attempt to "destroy" the Rohingyas. |
| <b>2022</b><br>July 22      | ICJ delivers verdict that Gambia's case can go ahead.                                                                                      |
