Another post seeker Tanbir Hasan Shaikat organised a photo exhibition, titled "The Politics of Killing People in arson terrorism by BNP-Jamaat" opposite to a human chain of pro-BNP

teachers which was held at the base of Aparajeyo Bangla. "We have remained active on the campus after getting instructions from the prime minister to remain vigilant to resist BNP," said Shaikat.

However, no JCD activists tried to enter the DU campus on rally day.

Their presence was not seen on the campus since last May after the BCL leaders announced their unwanted on the campus over a provocative comment about the PM.

"If we fail to flaunt our activities in such situations, it will create a negative image," a vice-president of the BCL central unit and a post-seeker, told this newspaper.

The DU authorities, however, said they expect regular academic activities to remain normal.

"The continuation of a congenial atmosphere is all that we want. We are always welcoming towards the regular students of the university," said DU Proctor Prof AKM Golam Rabbani.

## Little progress

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The issue of medicine doctors are needed to serve Chakaria. Currently, there are 13 doctors at Chakaria Upazila Health Complex.

"Containing AMR requires an all-out and multifaceted approach. All community clinics should have at least an assistant doctor," said Prof MA Faiz, former director general of the DGHS.

### NO LABS, PHARMACISTS IN HOSPITALS

Faiz said not having designated microbiology laboratories is a big weakness of public hospitals.

"At least all medical college hospitals [117] should have a well-equipped microbiology laboratory with the capacity to meet patients' diagnosis needs," Faiz said.

Echoing the same, Zakir said the existing microbiology labs at medical colleges cannot provide round the clock service.

Hospitals, moreover, lack antibiotic waste-management and good pharmacy practices, according to health officials.

Besides, there are no graduate pharmacists for counselling patients and auditing prescriptions.

The issue of medicine quality has not received proper attention during discussions on AMR, said experts.

"If the quality of medicines is not ensured and medicine wastes are not managed properly, only stopping irrational use will not be fruitful in containing AMR," Mehedi Hasan, technical officer at the US Pharmacopeial Convention, Bangladesh, told The Daily Star.

Over the last three years, Fleming Fund Country Grant has supported the refurbishing of 12 microbiology labs in different hospitals and livestock research centres.

"Everything should be integrated into the system. Otherwise, nothing will make a difference," Prof Nitish Debnath, team lead of the Fleming Fund programme in Bangladesh, told The Daily Star.

Prof Ahmedul Kabir, additional director general (administration) at the DGHS and co-chair of the national technical committee, said, "Fragmentation will not solve the problem. This is an entire system we need to work on collectively."

## Wage social movement

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Grant, stressed a social movement to deal with the crisis.

Prof Zahidul Hasan, renowned microbiologist and senior consultant at Square Hospitals, said, "Cheaper drugs like Cotrim and Ciprofloxacin were used to cure any infection. But there are now ineffective and we need to prescribe antibiotics which are more potent and cost around Tk 20,000 to cure a common infection."

Speakers at the event stressed spreading awareness to ensure the

judicious use of antibiotics.

Rakibul Hasan, senior specialist at National Curriculum and Textbook Board (NCTB), said they have the scope to include a chapter on AMR in their proposed books on health education at secondary-level schools from 2024.

Faculties and students from different medical colleges and universities, writers and journalists said they will be advocating on the threat of AMR in their arena.

Prof Tahmina Shirin, director of the IEDCR, presided over the event.

Plainclothes men identifying themselves as law enforcers picked up Fakhrul and Abbas from their homes around

3:00am on December 9.

The two BNP leaders were shown arrested on the charges of provoking party members to launch an attack on police in Nayapaltan area.

Another Dhaka court yesterday rejected bail petitions of 23 leaders and activists of BNP's front organisations and sent them to jail on completion of their two-day remand in two cases filed with Paltan and Motijheel police stations.
