True to the theme of this event, a serene corner of the park was picked to set up the premises of the event, with an abundance of open areas, children were seen running around, inquiring about the kinds of

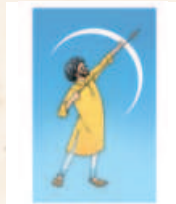

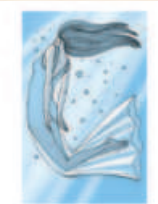
