

Brick kiln on farmland Construction work goes on defying ban

Construction of an illegal brick kiln on vast agricultural land in Kurigram's Ulipur upazila has been going on in full swing, defying ban from the local administration and Department of Environment (DoE).

Earlier in October, Ulipur upazila administration stopped the construction of the brick kiln at Hamirbazar under Tabakpur union, following complaints from the local farmers.

Locals alleged that construction work of the brick kiln has been restarted again as local administration has turned a blind eye to the wrongdoing due to unknown reason.

Farmers said Mahmudur Rahman Bakul, former chairman of Tabakpur Union Parishad (UP), started construction of the brick kiln at the beginning of August this year.

Although local people protested it, the owner didn't pay heed to their plea, they said.

Later, they submitted a written complaint to the upazila administration, agriculture department and DoE in this regard.



On October 25, a mobile court of DoE led by Ulipur UNO Subhan Rangsa went to the spot and stopped the construction work of the illegal brickfield.

The mobile court also directed its owner to remove the under-construction structure.

But instead of removing, construction work of the illegal brick kiln restarted last month.

Farmer Mojibar Rahman said, "If the brick kiln finally starts its operation, farmers won't be able to get expected crops production from the adjacent croplands."

Contacted, Mahmudur Rahman, owner of the brick kiln, refused to make any comment in this regard.

Ulipur upazila Agriculture Officer Saiful Islam said he has already written a letter to the administration to take immediate action against the illegal construction.

Kurigram DoE assistant director Rezaul Karim said the department has served a notice to the owner of the under-construction brick kiln last week.

Barguna chars abuzz with fish drying

Dry fish production has started in Barguna's Taltali upazila.

Fish drying is going on in full swing at Asharchar and other adjacent areas. The other areas include Sonakata and Jayalbhangha Char.

Usually, fish is dried in the sun during the winter season and the drying season starts in November, which continues for the next five months till March.

This year, fishers and traders started producing dry fish in a favourable environment, maintaining its original quality.

Traders said every year dry fish worth Tk 10 crore are produced in different areas of the upazila.

Livelihood of nearly one lakh people depend in this profession, where about 5,000 fishermen, labourers and traders are engaged.

Fishers said every week at least 100 to 150 maunds of dry fish are sold to the traders from different parts of the country from each Shutki Palli (spots for fish drying).

After netting the fish from the sea, fishers bring those to the Shutki Palli, where women wash them with fresh water and place the fish under the sun for drying.

It takes three to four days to produce the dried fish.

Around 25 species of fish including Rupchanda, Churi, Koral, Surma, Laitta, Shrimp, Vole and Poa are dried in different char areas of the upazila.

The demand for dried fish produced in the upazila is much higher as local fishers do not use any pesticides or extra salt in the processing work, said officials.

During a recent visit to Asharchar Shutki Palli, this correspondent

saw over 600 fishers and traders have built 32 makeshift houses to stay there for drying fishes.

Dry fish trader Rupchand Howladar said he has been involved in the business for nearly 40 years. "The business is good but things are getting expensive these days and we are worried," he said.

Barguna District Fisheries Officer Biswajit Kumar Dev said they will provide all kinds of support to the fishers and traders as hundreds of people are engaged with this trade.

Woman burnt in Mirpur fire dies

One of the two persons burnt in a fire in Dhaka's Mirpur on Saturday died yesterday.

The deceased -- Hazera Begum, 45 -- was undergoing treatment at Sheikh Hasina National Institute of Burn and Plastic Surgery with 50 percent burns, said its resident surgeon SM Ayub Hossain. Arian, 14, is fighting for his life with 70 percent burns.

The fire originated at a tin shed

house at section-13 in Mirpur around 4:00am while they were asleep, family members said.

Md Shahabuddin, senior station officer of Mirpur Fire Station, said the fire was doused before they reached the spot. "We primarily suspected that the fire originated from an electric short-circuit, which intensified after the air-conditioning exploded," he said.

Hazera's husband Abdus Salam said he was outside when the fire broke out. Arian is their tenant, he added.

Country victim of 'naked capitalism'

Prof Syed Anwar Hossain tells council of Jubo Maitree

Socialism is mentioned in our country's constitution but in reality a "naked capitalism" prevails in the country, said historian Prof Syed Anwar Hossain yesterday.

"Our Liberation War ended on December 16, 1971. But the war for our liberty is still ongoing. We are yet to get liberty. Farmers are being attacked," said the historian while addressing the eighth national council of Jubo Maitree.

Referring to the memoir of Che Guevara, he said "Che mentioned in his memoir how the farmers helped his guerilla army. During our Liberation War, 80 percent of the freedom fighters were farmers."

"The government filed cases against farmers, accusing them of loan defaulting, while the biggest loan defaulter is the Prime Minister's advisor," added Prof Husain.

Speaking at the event, Bangladesh Workers Party President Rashed Khan Menon urged Jubo Maitree activists to wage a movement against communalism and militancy.

Two motorbike riders were killed and another was injured when a truck ran them over in Cumilla yesterday.

The accident happened on Cumilla-Sylhet highway in front of Azghar Ali Girls High School in Debidwar area at 2:55pm, said Nazrul Islam, in-charge of Mirpur Highway Police Outpost.

Arif, son of Sharif Mia of Brahmanpara area, died on the spot and Irfan Imon, son of Matin Mia from Debidwar, succumbed to his injuries on the way to a hospital, said police.
