BIT strives for all its students to not only get admitted into the finest universities around the world but also attain prestigious scholarships. The feat is easier said than done but having a strong grasp of a second language makes the process easier. As a result, their curriculum is designed in a way that aligns with their objective.

Textbooks and syllabi are merely a fraction of what allows students to excel. To ensure that they're truly thriving, pupils must be given the right environment and BIT provides precisely that. They boast one of the largest private campuses in Dhaka with multiple top-of-

the-line amenities. For starters, there are a number of buildings within the facility that can accommodate up to 1800 enrolled students. In addition, the sports compound stretches up to 5.7 acres (18 bighas) of land and includes a standard-size football field as well as basketball and volleyball courts. The campus also includes a multipurpose hall and is equipped with a gymnasium for martial arts.

In addition, a music room was built specifically to host music classes and holds the capacity to practise dance and drama. Libraries boast a vast collection and laboratories offer all sorts of modern appliances. The campus is also recognised as an official venue for the O and A level examinations.
