

## How can a civilian sell govt land?

**BCL leader builds building on govt land; commuters suffer as road gets narrow**

The Water Development Board (WDB) owns a small piece of land by a flood-control embankment at Charmontaj Bazar area in Patuakhali's Rangabali upazila.

However, Wahid Khan Raj, deputy public education affairs secretary of Bangladesh Chhatra League's (BCL) central committee, and his brother Charmontaj Union Swechhchasebak League President Shahidul Khan are jointly constructing a five-storey building on this land.

Two floors of the building have already been completed. Meanwhile, many workers are working round the clock to finish the rest.

Sohrab Hossain, chief mason of the building, said the foundation of the building is for five floors.

Locals said the construction of the building started last year on the east side of Charmontaj Bazar, which is already a narrow strip.

They also said the space in this busy place has shrunk further due to the construction.

However, none of them wanted to come on record, fearing repercussions from the BCL leader and his brother.

Due to the structure, vehicles and motorcycles cannot pass freely, and this led to long tailbacks.

Contacted, Raj said, "I have bought this land legally from a man named Jewel Matubbar."

"However, Jewel took the money but did not complete the deed. It is expected that he will hand it over within a day or two," he added.

Contacted, Jewel Matubbar, who allegedly sold this government land, said, "I sold two decimals of the land to Raj and Shahidul Khan and received a total of Tk 3.5 crore."

"The land deed has not been handed over yet. But it will be completed within a day or two," he added.

However, he did not give any clear answer on how he could sell a government property.

Rangabali Upazila Assistant Commissioner (Land) Mohammad Salek Muhid, said, "We will take action after an inquiry."

Contacted, Kalapara WDB Executive Engineer Arif Hossain, said, "There is no opportunity to construct buildings by occupying the WDB's land."

"We were not aware of this. We will send a monitoring officer there soon and take necessary measures," he added.

## Municipality itself piles up waste in open space

In absence of a designated dumping station, the Bagerhat municipality authority has been dumping tonnes of waste in the open space at Majhidanga area, creating serious environment pollution and posing health risk for the townspeople.

Due to the unplanned waste dumping, residents of the area are the worst sufferers.

Locals said the accumulated pile of garbage has been causing severe environmental pollution in the area.

Moreover, the townspeople have been suffering immensely due to the stench coming out from the

heap of the garbage.

In June, 2019, the municipality authority started constructing a dumping station, at a cost of Tk 10 crore, but the work hasn't progressed that much.

Apart from the land acquisition, no visible work has been done in the last three and a half years.

In the meantime, the environment is being polluted continuously due to the increasing amount of household and industrial wastes dumped throughout all these years.

While visiting the place recently, this correspondent experienced unbearable foul odour emanating from the pile of garbage, brought

from different areas of the municipality.

Many pedestrians were seen crossing the dumping spot holding their noses.

Local Jalil Sheikh said it has become very difficult for them to live there due to the bad odour.

During rain, the heap of garbage spreads on the road, and pedestrians are forced to move by stepping over the waste, said Sadia Akhter, a student.

Bagerhat Department of Environment (DoE) Deputy Director Kamruzzaman Sarkar said it's the responsibility of the municipality authority to ensure proper garbage-

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## BANGABANDHU BRIDGE Dense fog leads to traffic congestion

According to Traffic Control Room sources of Bangabandhu Bridge and police, the traffic was hampered from 1:00am due to poor visibility beyond 40 metres. At 3:00am, the authorities restricted traffic on the bridge to avoid accidents as the situation got worse.

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## Two cousins die in Habiganj road crash

Two cousins were killed as a covered-van hit their motorcycle in Madhabpur upazila of Habiganj on Tuesday night.


The accident took place on Dhaka Sylhet highway in Muktiyoddha Chattar area around 11:30pm.

The deceased were identified as Sohag Mia, 17, son of Aftab Hossain, and his cousin Shubo Mia, 18, son of Imam Hossain from the upazila.

Shayestaganj Highway Police Station Officer-in-Charge Mainul Islam Bhuiyan and locals told The Daily Star that after Sohag and Shubo reached Muktiyoddha Chattar, a Dhaka-bound covered-van from Sylhet ran over the motorcycle.

Locals took them to Madhabpur Upazila Health Complex where they were declared dead.


