AL ends it on a high note despite poor start

Political activities of the ruling Awami League in 2022 began slowly, after a quiet pandemic, and gathered significant momentum towards the end of the year. The activities gathered pace largely due to the AL

and the government's events and the programmes the party launched to counter the BNP's agitations, mostly rallies and processions after August 22.

The pandemic compelled AL President Sheikh Hasina to avoid public appearances but she started showing up at

BNP's year of dramatic rebound

The year 2022 marked a major turnaround for the BNP as the party seemed to have overcome the organisational weaknesses and political inertia that had been plaguing it since the disappointing results of the 2018 national polls.
