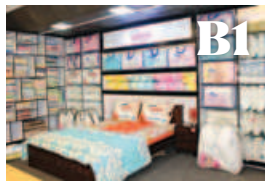

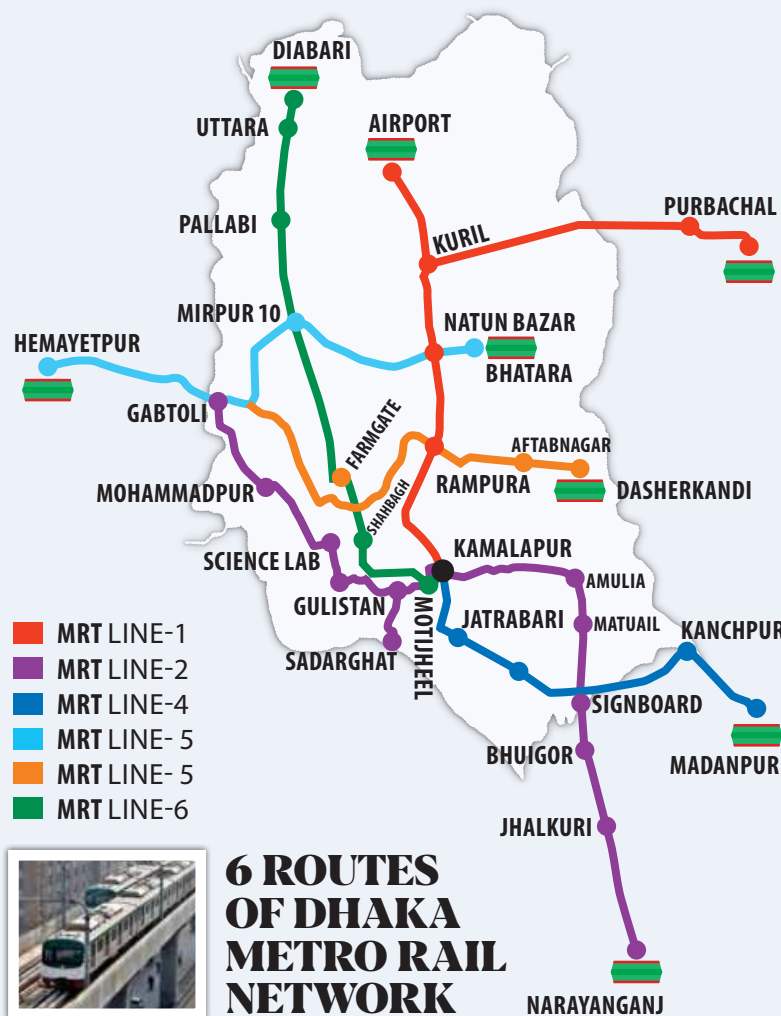

Rickshaw-puller dies as Jubo League man opens fire

A rickshaw-puller died and two others were injured after being shot allegedly by a Jubo League man during a clash between two rival groups in Poshchim Tengri area of Pabna's Ishwardi upazila.

The dead was identified as Md Mamun Hossain, 26, son of Manik Hossain.

According to police and locals, the incident occurred around 9:00pm when the two rival groups locked into a clash regarding compensation for a vehicle that was involved in a minor accident.

Quoting locals, Arbinda Sarker, officer-in-charge of Ishwardi Police Station, said, "A Nosimon [a three-wheeler] and a human hauler had collided in the area. A group of locals caught the Nosimon driver and demanded compensation for the damages [a broken glass] caused to the human hauler. Meanwhile, another group gathered taking the Nosimon driver's side.

"While the two groups argued, Jubo League activist Anwar Hossain and his associates suddenly appeared on the scene and opened fire indiscriminately on the group taking the human hauler driver's side."

Mamun was bullet-hit and died on the way to hospital. Police rescued the others injured, Sumon Hossain, 28, and Roky
