Date palm trees on the decline in Chattogram

The number of date palm trees fell to 2,270 from 3,719 in Chattogram's coastal areas in the last 10 years – a decline of 39 percent, according to data obtained from the forest department.

The reasons behind the decline are deforestation and natural disaster, forest officials said.

Data from the coastal forest department of Chattogram showed that there were 3,719 date palm trees in 2013.

This data is only for the coastal areas of Chattogram, the Department of Agricultural Extension (DAE) in the district doesn't have the exact number of date palm trees in the division.

During a recent visit to the Sitakunda upazila, this correspondent found Mizanur Rahman, who was collecting juice from a tree.

He told The Daily Star that due to the decline of date palm trees, farmers who formerly relied on it for their livelihood now chose other sources of income.

"We now sell raw date palm juice at Tk 40 per litre," he added.

Nurul Aber, a date farmer of Rangunia upazila, told this newspaper that he sells around 12 to 15 litres of date palm juice daily.



"Every day I earn Tk 800 to Tk 1,000," he said.

Khaled Misbahuzzaman, professor of the Institute of Forestry and Environmental Sciences at Chittagong University, said date palm is one of the most important fruit trees grown and is a good income source for farmers.

Coconut and date palm trees also protect coastal areas from disasters like cyclones or floods. "Therefore, it's

Use of shallow machines for irrigation raising cost

Only a couple of weeks ago, the flow of water in Teesta river was enough to facilitate farming, but the mighty waterbody has completely dried up in many places of Lalmonirhat since then.

As a result, many farmers in different char areas of the district, who cultivate various crops on the sandy char lands, are compelled to use diesel-run shallow machines to

irrigate their croplands.

Farmers are relentlessly working to produce various types of vegetables like potatoes, pumpkins, maize, onions and chillies on the vast sandy land by the Teesta.

Farmer Rustam Ali of Char Gokunda village in Sadar upazila said he has planted potatoes and chillies on his land.

But as there is no water in Teesta, he had to set up a shallow machine on the riverbed to irrigate his potato

and chilly fields, Rustam said.

Echoing Rustam, Aziz Uddin, a farmer from the same village, added that using the machines means increased production cost.

Another farmer, Moksedul Islam of Char Bhotmari village in Kaliganj upazila, said huge amounts of water are required for potato and pumpkin cultivation.

'It cannot exclude freedom fighters' names from gazette'

The High Court yesterday observed that Jatiya Muktiyoddha Council has no jurisdiction to cancel the gazette which includes the names of freedom fighters after scrutinising those through the committee concerned.

With the observation, the court declared illegal the decision of Jatiya Muktiyoddha Council that excluded names of 22 naval commando freedom fighters of Gaibandha's Gobindganj from the official gazette.

The HC bench of Justice Zubayer Rahman Chowdhury and Justice Kazi Ebadath Hossain delivered the verdict after holding hearing of a writ petition filed by the 22 freedom fighters challenging the legality of Jatiya Muktiyoddha

Youth killed as truck hits bicycle

A youth was killed when a truck hit his bicycle in Chapainawabganj yesterday.

The accident happened around 8:45am in Chiniatala area under Gomostapur upazila, said police.

Shahin Alam, 22, of Chandona Jadupur village in Nachole upazila, was declared dead at Gomostapur Upazila Health Complex after locals took him there.

OC Mahbubur Rahman of Gomostapur Police Station, said the accident occurred while Shahin was going to Rohonpur on his bicycle from his village home. Police recovered his body and sent it to a local hospital morgue for autopsy, he said.
