Cox’s Bazar hospital gets new outpatient department

A new outpatient department complex for the 250-bed district hospital in Cox’s Bazar, funded by UNHCR, began operations yesterday.

UNHCR constructed, equipped and furnished the complex to provide timely lifesaving medical treatment and secondary care to Bangladeshis and Rohingya refugees, said a statement. Services will include eye and dental care and medical and surgical consultations. Modern lifts, fire-fighting system, and equipment will help enhance access to healthcare.

The outpatient department can facilitate surgeries, and orthopaedic, dental, and maternal and paediatric care, said Health Minister Zahid Maleque.

An effort to meet HOUSING DEMAND

CDA to implement new project in port city

Chattogram Development Authority (CDA) will implement a new housing project in the port city to fulfil the rising demand for homes amid a rapidly expanding urban population.

CDA has already chosen an area for the project, which is intended to house a sizable section of the population, whose housing needs will only increase due to expanding economic activity in the city.

Under the project, authorities will develop land to make it ideal for constructing buildings.


The development authority sent a detailed project plan (DPP) for the “Bayazid Housing Project”, which will be implemented in Bayazid Bostami area, to the housing ministry for approval.

The ministry has formed a committee for implementation, headed by the ministry’s joint secretary. Committee members recently visited the project site.

However, there are some errors in the DPP sent by CDA, and for this, the ministry has directed authorities to correct and send it again, said Kazi Kader Newaz, project director and CDA engineer.

Authorities will send the revised DPP to the ministry within a month.

It will cost Tk 40 lakh to develop one residential plot and Tk 1 crore for a commercial plot. The project outline states that CDA will develop 167 residential and 18 commercial plots on Lope Road in Bayazid Bostami area.

UK providing Tk 6cr for Sylhet flood victims

The UK is contributing an additional £5 lakh (around Tk 6.60 crore) in humanitarian support to respond to last year’s flooding in Sylhet region, the incident in which 7.2 million people were affected.

The funding, which will be delivered by Brac, will provide water, shelter, opportunities to ensure livelihood, and improved nutrition for people affected in Sunamganj, Sylhet, said the UK High Commission in Bangladesh in a statement yesterday. Earlier, the UK provided £6,36,548 (over Tk 7 crore) to the flood victims in Sylhet.

Matt Cannell, development director at the commission, said last year’s devastating floods in Sylhet region underline that Bangladesh remains vulnerable to the impacts of climate change.

“This new funding provides vital water, nutrition, shelter and livelihood opportunities to some of the worst affected communities in Sunamganj, Sylhet. The UK is proud to partner with Brac to deliver this support,” the statement said. This new UK support will ensure safe water and shelter for nearly 1,000 affected households and restore livelihoods and food security for more than 5,000.

Brac Executive Director Asif Saleh said the floods in northeastern Bangladesh in June 2022 were the worst to hit Bangladesh in the last two decades. They left a trail of destruction in nine districts, with Sunamganj being the worst affected.

Significant efforts were undertaken to provide emergency response to meet immediate needs, but sustained humanitarian support is direly needed to help people recover and rebuild their lives, he said.

Shoe depot gutted in Ctg fire

A shoe warehouse was gutted at Nupur Market in the port city’s Kotowali area yesterday.

The fire originated around 3:30pm at a godown of Al Madina Shoes on the sixth floor of the market, said Anisur Rahman, deputy director of the Chattogram fire service.

On information, firefighters rushed to the spot and doused the fire after nearly two hours, he said.

There were no casualties in the fire.

Anisur Rahman said the flames gutted a huge quantity of shoes and raw materials stored in the warehouse. Eight fire brigade units managed to douse the fire at around 5:10pm.

The cause of the fire could not be determined immediately.
