At least 7 dengue patients were hospitalised in the last 24 hours till yesterday morning.

With the new ones, the total number of dengue cases this year rose to 377, according to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS).

Some 123 dengue patients are still undergoing treatment across the country. The total number of deaths in dengue was 281 last year while the total number of cases was 62,382, of which 23,162 were from outside Dhaka, according to the DGHS.
