Mariam, 7, daughter of Masud Mridha of Sutabaria village in the district's Galachipa upazila, and Rafia, 4, daughter of Nizam Mridha of the same village, drowned in a pond near their house on December

When Rafia fell into the waterbody, her cousin Mariam jumped into the pond to save her baby sister, but both perished. Relatives later recovered their floating bodies.

Masum said, "The pond was unfenced. If it had been netted, my child would not have drowned."

The World Health the upazila called Anchal. children drowning in Organization (WHO) has recommended 10 essential measures to prevent child drowning.
