The DC also mentioned that he will hold a meeting on January 23 with all the concerned parties regarding the matter and visit the indigenous communities in Sherpur upazila.  
On January 8, local Bangalees and indigenous communities logged into a land-related clash. At least 30 people were injured from both sides. Two days later, another attacked was launched on two indigenous youths.

Since last December, local Bangalees have barred the indigenous peoples from cultivating their four-bigha land in Amboil village, claiming to own it. They claim the land was sold by the forefathers of its current indigenous owners to their families.  
After these attacks, around 700 indigenous families in five villages are passing their days in confinement out of fear of being attacked again, they said.

US didn't impose

He was speaking to journalists after a meeting with Malaysian High Commissioner Haznah Md Hashim at his ministry office in Secretariat.  
Replying to a question, Anisul said he did not discuss with Donald Lu about when the sanction might be withdrawn, as there is a legal procedure for it.  
"We are going ahead in accordance with legal procedure, and hope that the sanction will be lifted through this procedure," he said.  
In response to another query, he said there is no scope for reintroducing the caretaker government system in the country as the Appellate Division of the Supreme Court has scrapped this system and constitution has been amended to this effect.  
Donald Lu did neither say that a participatory election must be held in Bangladesh nor gave any instruction that the election will have to be held in this way or that way, he said. They (US) only want that the democracy of Bangladesh develops and the methods for the development of democracy are used properly.  
The law minister

informed that he requested Lu to take steps so that the US deport Rashed Chowdhury, a convicted killer of Bangabandhu, to Bangladesh.  
"He asked me to communicate with the justice department of the US for this purpose. We will do that. Besides, we will knock all the doors to bring him (Rashed) back to Bangladesh," he said.  
Replying to a question, Anisul said the government does not take any action to harass BNP men, but takes necessary steps to protect the safety and properties of people.  
He said the situation in Brahmanbaria court has improved a lot as the lawyers are now boycotting courts of two judges. "Had I known about it, things would not have come this far. I hope that the problems there will be solved soon," he said.  
He also said during yesterday's meeting, he requested the Malaysian government through its high commissioner to ask Myanmar to take Rohingya people from Bangladesh back to that country and take more Bangladeshi workers to Malaysia.  
The Malaysian envoy replied in the positive, he said.

Muzahidul, also a director of Bangla Academy, claimed that the police administration also objected to the books.  
The decision was harshly criticised by writers on social media.  
Mahabub Rahman, chief executive officer of Adarsha, said, "Have no other political or ideological relationship with the authors apart from the author-publisher one. We pledge to publish and distribute books to readers regardless of the situation we are in."  
He claimed that in 2019, similar allegations were made against Adarsha but they were proven wrong. "I have no hidden political agenda either. I only believe in the freedom of expression of a writer."

up posters when the advertising boards are set up at the locations. If councillors don't put them at the right places, this will not be successful," he added.  
Meanwhile, DNCC issued a letter related to this initiative yesterday afternoon.  
The letter states that the city's beauty is being ruined by posters everywhere. To protect its beauty, it is necessary to stop putting up posters at random locations.  
There are specific laws regarding the placement of posters, banners and festoons. DNCC has also issued a warning on this, the letter read.  
According to DNCC

sources, a physical board has been set up at Mirpur 10 Roundabout for posters on trial basis. The ward councillor chose the location, and the corporation authorities set it up there. This will be replicated in every ward.  
Mukbul Hossain, public relations officer of DNCC, said, "We are trying to make people aware of the laws and regulations related to the placement of posters, banners and festoons. If anyone breaks the rules, DNCC will take legal action."  
Murad Hossain, councillor of ward-12 under DNCC, said he received instructions from the city corporation regarding the initiative, but work has not started in his ward yet.
