# NATIONAL FILM AWARDS 2021 ANNOUNCED

# 34 awards will be given in 27 categories

**The National** Film Award is considered to be one the most prestigious prizes given for films in Bangladesh.

Yesterday, the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting has announced the final recipients of the National Film Awards 2021.

The National Film Award is considered to be one the most prestigious prizes given for films in Bangladesh. Every year, the government honours artistes in various categories, for their contributions towards the film industry.

Usually, the National Film Award is given in a total of 28 categories. However, this year 34 awards will be given in 27 categories. The 'Best Dance Director' category has been dropped Kabbo.

Siam Ahmed (*Mridha Bonam Mridha*) and Mir Sabbir (Raat Jaga Phool) will be jointly taking the 'Best Actor' award home.

Similarly, the 'Best Actress' award will also be jointly given to Azmeri Haque Badhan (**Rehana Maryam Noor**), and Tasnova Tamanna (Nonajoler Kabbo).

While the 'Best Supporting Actor' award goes to Fazlur Rahman Babu, for his performance in Nonajoler Kabbo; Shampa Reza will receive the 'Best Supporting Actress' award for Poddapuran. The 'Best Actor in a Negative Role' award will go to Joyraj for Lal

Sayba Talukder, from the team of Rehana Maryam Noor will be picking up the 'Best Sound Designer' award, while 'Best Costume Designer and Makeup' will be going to Edila Farid Turin (Nonajoler Kabbo) and Md Farukh, Md Farhad, and Reza Milon (Lal Moroger Jhuti).

Dhar, produced by AKA Reza Ghalib, will be recognised as the 'Best Short Film', while the 'Best Documentary Film' award will go to Boddhyo Bhumi, produced by Kauser Chowdhury.

On August 16, the Information and Broadcasting Ministry formed a 13-member jury board. In 2021, 21 full-fledged films, 17 short films and 7 documentary films—totaling 45 films—were submitted for the National Film

> The BERC is an autonomous body established based on the Bangladesh Energy Regulatory Commission Act 2003, aiming at improving power and energy infrastructure in Bangladesh. The law has previously been amended three times.

With the amendment of the 2003 act, the ministry will not be required to hold a hearing to decide new prices for gas and electricity.

On November 28, the cabinet approved an amendment to the BERC Act 2003 to empower the government to set fuel tariffs on its own under special circumstances without waiting for the commission's public hearing and decision.

In panic, around 300 Marma people of 45 families took shelter at the Marma Welfare Association and over 50 Bawm people at Bawm Social Council Association Club's hall room in Ruma town, he said.

# Israel moves to punish

The punitive measures announced are in line with proposals from Netanyahu's extreme-right political partners, whose support enabled him to return to power at the end of December.

They are likely to apply primarily to Palestinians with Israeli nationality, known as Arab-Israelis, and Palestinians with residency permits for annexed east Jerusalem.

old Palestinian boy shot and wounded Israelis killed. two Israelis just outside the walled Old City of east Jerusalem.

The boy blamed for the attack in the Silwan neighbourhood was shot and wounded at the scene and detained.
