The fair was organised by the US embassy in Bangladesh, through its EducationUSA platform, which helps students from around the world to apply and join American institutions for higher studies, in partnership with EdPrograms, at a city hotel.

The 13 universities that participated were -- Iowa State University, University of New Haven, University of Delaware, Stony Brook University, Quinnipiac University, Colorado State University, Western Kentucky University, Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, Trine University, The University of Texas at Arlington and the University of Arizona.

Mexican foreign

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Simancas Marin, non-resident ambassador of Cuba; Sinisa Pavic, non-resident ambassador of Serbia; and Menzie Siphon Dlamini, non-resident high commissioner of the Kingdom of Eswatini, jointly met Momen at the Foreign Service Academy yesterday, following presentation of their letter of credence to Bangladesh president at Bangabhaban.

At the outset, the Momen welcomed the non-resident ambassadors to Bangladesh.
At the meeting, Momen hoped that the

bilateral relations among Bangladesh and the countries would usher a new avenue during their tour of duty.

Non-resident ambassadors cordially exchanged views on bilateral and multilateral cooperation of mutual interests, including trade and investment, infrastructure development, connectivity, Covid situation, and Russia-Ukraine crisis, which disrupted the supply chain of wheat, fuel and edible oil and discussed ways and means to address the issue to offset the crisis.

Peace remains

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the government against the implementation of the accord," Saikhin said.

Shah Alam, president of Communist Party of Bangladesh, said it was the Awami League government that signed the peace accord. "They have been in power for 14 years with a landslide majority in the parliament. They can easily implement the accord if they are cordial about the issue."

Bajlur Rashid Firoj, general secretary of Bangladesher Samajtantrik Dal (BSD), said the government must fully

implement the CHT Peace Accord to fulfil its promises to the people of CHT and ensure their rights.

Poet and journalist Abul Momen, who presided over the rally, said big political parties in the country are silent on this issue. "The parties are fighting over power. It is the moral duty of Bangladeshis and the people of the hills to pressurise the government into implementing the accord."

Following the rally, a mass procession was brought out, which paraded the main thoroughfares of the port city.

Ensure recreation

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spaces for children have shrunk following implementation of various development projects in Dhaka.

Professionals involved in the design and implementation of such projects must have to take responsibility for this, he added.

Farhana Rashid, chief executive officer of Bhumijo, presented the possible design of a playground for children

in Bauniyabandh area of Mirpur.

According to Maruf Hossain, UNDP's town manager, many children's playgrounds are being walled off to restrict access. The universality of the mass sphere is largely destroyed by such a design.

Mostak Hussain, director (humanitarian) of Save the Children Bangladesh, said it is only through environmentally friendly and inclusive

participation that the slum area can be made sustainable.

Dhaka North City Corporation city planner Maksud Hashem stated that there have been several positive changes in the creation of public spaces in Dhaka. He added that the City Corporation is sincerely interested in creating recreational facilities and spaces for the city's marginalized children.

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Myanmar, which may not be good for Bangladesh at this moment."

He emphasised that Bangladesh should not encourage or actively participate in creating a battlefield in Myanmar when Rohingyas who belong to that country are already in its territory.

Rohingya community leader Dr Hla Myint said, "We are the most persecuted community in the world. We demand the right to self-determination and we want to reach out

to international actors for the interest of the Rohingya people globally and locally."

Prof Zaw Wai Soe, union minister of Myanmar's National Unity Government (NUG), expressed a strong commitment to voluntary, safe and dignified repatriation of the Rohingyas.

Zaw said, "Rohingyas are my people. We will not tolerate any discrimination against them and will work together with all our allies to end the military dictatorship and build a state where basic

human rights can be valued and exercised."

The minister also expressed NUG's disappointment over the invitation sent to Myanmar's junta government for the upcoming ASEAN defence minister's meeting and military drill.

The discussants urged the international community to take urgent action and ensure that Myanmar can return to democracy and that the human rights of the country's citizens are respected.

BNP marches from Gabtoli

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In a brief address prior to launching the march, Mosharraf said whenever BNP announces any programme, the "usurper" government tries to mislead people by talking about violence. "But BNP has held 10 rallies peacefully, braving various obstacles. We also held many other programmes peacefully. The fact is that the government gets scared of losing power whenever BNP comes up with any programme."

Another BNP standing committee member, Nazrul Islam Khan, said people are going through a very tough time due to unusual price hikes for all essential items.

He said the government is also raising the prices of utility services as it has "taken a stance against the country's people".

Thousands of leaders and activists of BNP and its associate bodies joined the programme, carrying banners, national and

party flags, festoons and portraits of the party's top leaders.

A huge number of law enforcers were deployed in the area to maintain law and order.

Earlier on Thursday, BNP announced the four-day march programme in the capital for January 28, 30, 31 and February 1.

The programme will conclude with Dhaka south city unit's march from Mugda to Malibagh today.
