In the video clip, Najibul Bashar said, "My sons took a loan of Tk 39.40 crore from a bank and they repaid around Tk 65 crore to the bank later. But the ACC did not mention the information in the case it filed against my sons."

Contacted, Taibul Bashar said, "It's totally a politically motivated case filed with an ill intention to demean my father politically.... The bank from which we took the loan did not file any case against us, but ACC did and concealed the information that we have repaid the loan."

Asked about the allegation, ACC Assistant Director Saiful Islam, also the case's IO, said the case was lodged based on documentary evidence and following approval by the commission.
