

GUN ATTACK ON AL LEADER Case filed accusing 6

A case was filed yesterday over the gun attack on Narsingdi's Shibpur upazila chairman Harunur Rashid, accusing six people including Arif Sarkar.

In the case, filed by the victim's son Amminur Rashid Khan, Arif is mentioned as the mastermind behind the attack, which took place on Saturday. But the complainant did not mention any motive for it.

The other five accused are Mohsin Mia, 32, Iran Mia, 30, Shakil Mia, 35, Humayun, 32, and Nur Mohammad, 48.

Firoz Talukder, officer-in-charge of Shibpur Police Station, said, "We seized a car and unregistered motorcycle, which were used during the attack on Harunur, from the possession of four detainees."

"We produced them before a court in Narsingdi seeking a five day remand, but it granted one day. We hope we will get information about the motive behind the attack."

The OC said, "Primarily, we are suspecting that the attack was carried out due to political reasons."

Hasan Sani Alich, chairperson of Puthia Union Parishad and the union's AL president, said, "Arif Sarkar has no involvement with Awami League or its associated bodies."

10 hurt as AL factions clash in Tangail

At least 10 people, including two journalists, were injured in a clash between two rival factions of Awami League in Tangail's Ghatail upazila yesterday.

According to party sources, the clash ensued because of a dispute over the party's newly-formed upazila committee.

Police and witnesses said the clash took place at Ghatail Bus

Stand area on Tangail-Mymensingh highway in the afternoon. At that time, traffic came to a halt.

Ghatail upazila AL committee was formed on January 28. Committee president and Ghatail upazila parishad chairman Shahidul Islam Lebu announced the committee.

Alleging that the committee was formed by keeping BNP-Jamaat men, the followers of local lawmaker Aatur Rahman Khan rejected the committee and held a

press conference and protest rally on Sunday.

Tensions reached their peak when both the rival factions announced a programme at the same venue yesterday.

At one stage, the supporters of both groups locked into a clash.

Contacted, Azharul Islam Sarkar, officer-in-charge of Ghatail Police Station, told The Daily Star that police dispersed the AL activists as soon as they could.

The clash ensued because of a dispute over the party's newly-formed upazila committee, between supporters of upazila parishad chairman Shahidul Islam Lebu and local lawmaker Aatur Rahman Khan.

CPA rejoinder, our reply

Auditor General (CAG) that it violated rules during the procurement of a high-power tugboat.

The Anti-Corruption Commission too found no anomalies during the procurement of the tugboat, CPA said in the rejoinder.

Due diligence and compliance with applicable laws, rules and procedures were observed strictly at every step of the tender procedure. No financial loss was incurred by CPA or the government in this procurement process.

CPA said it has withheld 30 percent of the contracted price to the builder amounting to Tk 11.32 crore and will clear it if the tugboat performs satisfactorily

after deducting liquidated damages.

It also maintains that there were no anomalies in the docking and repairing of MT Kandari-1 by Chittagong Dry Dock.

The port authority maintains that it deducted income tax from the bill of berth operators as per section 52A of the income tax ordinance 1984 from fiscals 2017-18 to 2019-20.

"So, no loss occurred for the government," it said.

CPA said it gave incentive bonuses to its officers and staff in fiscal 2019-20 as per the shipping ministry's refixed target.

It, however, did not dispute that it was an outstanding amount in rent. However, the amount is Tk 25.36 crore and not Tk 30

crore, as mentioned in the CAG report.

Due to pending litigation with the private lessee, the outstanding amount could not be realised in proper time.

"Collection of outstanding dues is a continuous process. CPA is taking effective measures for timely collection of those dues."

There was no financial irregularity during CPA's rental of cars and minibuses.

There was also no deviation from government rules regarding CPA officials and staff's foreign tours.

"After completion of the visit, all officers and staff have to submit their TA/DA bills including air ticket as per government rules,

which has been followed in every visit programme."

CPA, however, acknowledged that it has outstanding dues in its share of sales proceeds of auctioned goods between fiscal 2017-18 and fiscal 2019-20.

As of December last year, the outstanding amount is Tk 1.3 crore.

"Despite repeated requests (verbally and written), Custom did not pay CPA's share. However, CPA is pursuing the matter with Custom."

Our reply
The Daily Star report was based on the CAG report that found 26 counts of irregularities by the CPA between fiscal 2017-18 and 2019-20. As such, we stand by our report.

division 13.58 percent.

Economists are not in agreement with the government's line of thinking.

"This is going the opposite direction to what the current economic circumstances demand," said Zahid Hussain, a former lead economist of the World Bank's Dhaka office.

The ADP is a formidable weapon in the government's arsenal against the raging dollar crisis and high inflation. But the government wasted it.

As of February 22, foreign currency reserves stood at \$32.4 billion, enough to cover about four months' imports,

according to data from the Bangladesh Bank.

The average inflation in the first seven months of the fiscal year is upwards of 8 percent, comfortably overshooting the budgetary target.

"The government-financed import-intensive projects must be cut or else, the dollar crisis will not go away."

In fact, it will make the situation worse as more dollars would be needed for imports on the government's own-funded projects, he said.

"We simply can't use foreign funds effectively and speedily. Regrettably, we needed to use the foreign funds the most, which would take away the pressure on reserves. We

are doing the opposite," said Ahsan H Mansur, executive director of the Policy Research Institute.

At the same time, to bring down the high inflation, the government-financed projects should have been condensed, Hussain said.

"Those create demand and fan inflation. There is no point in pouring money into the economy -- that money has to enter the production system. Because of the dollar shortage, the economy is stalling. Because of inflation, people cannot buy things. If you bring down inflation, with the same income the people would be able to buy more," he added.

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The security in the areas where the PM will visit, including the Helipad Ground, has been beefed up.

senseless Russian invasion of Ukraine."

Following the speeches by the UN top brass, nearly 150 ministers and heads of state and government are due to speak, virtually or in person, during the first four days of the session.

Among them will be the foreign ministers of the United States, China, Ukraine and Iran.

Moscow will send Deputy Foreign Minister Sergey Ryabkov to address the council in person on Thursday.

Despite calls from NGOs, observers said it was unlikely there would be a walkout like the one many diplomats took part in when Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov's video played in the council last year.

being placed as a bill in parliament.

On another amendment proposal sent to the law ministry, Rashida said that the law ministry said some voters being allowed to vote when their fingerprints do not match with the ones in the EC database need not be included in the proposals.

"Representatives of the law ministry said these powers could be given to the election officials through

rules," she said while talking to reporters at her EC office.

Now, the commission issues circulars to give the presiding officers and assistant presiding officers the power to allow up to 1 percent of the voters in a polling booth to cast their votes via EVMs after fingerprint mismatch.

A few months ago, the EC asked the law ministry to include this in the RPO, the law that regulates the national election.

On August 8 last year, the commission sent the proposals for amendments to the RPO. As the law ministry's Legislative and Parliamentary Affairs Division did not respond, the EC wrote again seeking an answer on September 28 and then again on October 10.

The EC on November 27 said the law ministry was yet to respond to its letters regarding the proposed amendments.
