

INDIA'S ELECTION COMMISSION

SC overhauls commissioner appointment

India's top court yesterday ordered the setting up of a bipartisan panel that will include the prime minister and the chief justice to select the country's election commissioners, ending a practice of the government effectively choosing them.

The Election Commission of India is an autonomous constitutional authority but opposition parties have regularly accused it of caving into the demands of the ruling party, a charge it has denied.

The new panel will also include the leader of the opposition in the lower house of parliament or the opposition party with the highest number of members in the house. "This norm will continue to hold good till a law is made by parliament," said Justice K.M. Joseph, delivering the order of a constitution bench that heard several petitions calling for an independent committee to appoint election commissioners.

Prashant Bhushan, a lawyer representing the petitioners, termed the judgment "historic".

GENDER EQUALITY

Reforms at slowest pace since 2001: WB

Legal reforms toward equal rights for women around the globe fell to the slowest pace in more than two decades last year, despite positive developments in sub-Saharan Africa, the World Bank (WB) said yesterday. Just 34 reforms to improve women's economic participation were made in the year to October 2022, down from a peak of 73 in 2008, the bank said in a statement, suggesting "legal fatigue" may have set in among countries looking to reach gender equality. At the current pace, the bank calculated that it would take at least another half century to pass the more than 1,500 legal reforms needed to reach "substantial gender equality everywhere." "Denying equal rights to women across much of the world is not just unfair to women; it is a barrier to... development," said WB's chief economist, Indermit Gill.

GREEK TRAIN CRASH

Outrage grows as govt admits 'failures'

The Greek government yesterday acknowledged failures in state management of its rail system, following a train collision that killed 48 and has triggered angry protests.

As crews continued to work in the charred wreckage at the crash site, the local station master admitted negligence in Greece's worst ever rail disaster and the government has apologised.

An investigation would examine the "chronic delays in implementing railway works, delays caused by chronic public sector malaise and decades of failure," said a government spokesman. The crash happened late Tuesday when a freight and passenger train were allowed to speed towards each other for several kilometres before colliding near a tunnel outside Larissa in central Greece.

BJP retains Tripura, Nagaland

Meghalaya appears set for hung parliament

The Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) and its allies -- IPFT and NDDP -- retain power in Tripura and Nagaland, as per the latest trends post the initial rounds of counting in these two northeast states in India.

Meanwhile, Meghalaya appears to be headed towards a hung assembly with the Conrad Sangma-led NPP emerging as the single-largest party.

The elections for Tripura assembly were held on February

16, where 89.95 percent of the 28.14 lakh voters exercised their franchise. The elections for Meghalaya and Nagaland assemblies were conducted on February 27.

BJP and IPFT allies won 31 seats in the 60-member Tripura assembly, securing its return to power in the northeastern state for the second time in a row, reports TNN.

According to the Election Commission website, the BJP bagged 30 seats while the Indigenous People's Front of

Tripura (IPFT) got one.

The saffron party is leading in two more seats, according to the latest release of the results.

"The BJP's victory was expected... We were eagerly waiting for it. Our responsibility has been increased with the decisive mandate," outgoing Chief Minister Manik Saha.

The party's poll machine remains in fine fettle. A comfortable win in Tripura proves that its performance in 2018 was no fluke and it is now the party to beat in the state.

Ultra-rich lost 10pc of fortune in 2022

The world's ultra-richest saw their fortunes shrink by 10 percent in 2022, due to the war in Ukraine, a study said Wednesday, but the outlook for them this year is bright. The study, by London-based property consultants Knight Frank, examined the fortunes of what it calls ultra-high-net-worth individuals (UHNWIs): people with a net worth of at least \$30 million including their main residence. "Challenging markets meant the majority of UHNWIs saw their wealth decline last year, with their collective wealth falling by 10 percent," said the report -- the equivalent of \$10.1 trillion, it added. "Last year the Ukraine crisis fuelled the European energy crunch and supercharged already surging inflation," said Liam Bailey, Knight Frank's global head of research.
