

CLASH IN PANCHAGARH

A heartbreaking reunion

Abu Bakkar Siddique, a resident of Natore, met his son at Panchagarh Sadar upazila after some months. They had planned to enjoy each other's company at Jalsa Salana, an annual gathering for people belonging to the Ahmadiyya community. But hours after they met, the reunion turned into a tragedy, as Siuddique's son Jahid Hasan, 23, became a victim of brutality. On Friday, two people, including Jahid, were killed in a clash between law enforcers and supporters of some Islamist organisations who were demonstrating against Jalsa Salana. Jahid graduated in engineering from TMSS University of Bogura recently and joined a private company. He joined Jalsa Salana on Friday morning from Dhaka, while his father reached the venue on Thursday from their ancestral home. While visiting the spot at Ahmednagar, Siddique was seen sitting on a vehicle, in complete silence, carrying his son's body. He talked to this correspondent just before leaving the Jalsa compound along with the body on Saturday afternoon. Tears were rolling down his cheeks. "We came to join a holy event, but unfortunately,

my son met the tragic end of his life, which was beyond my imagination. Everything is over... Now I have nothing to look forward to..." he said. At a press conference held at the venue on Saturday, Ahmad Tabshir Chowdhury – convener of Jalsa Salana, the three-day event organised by the Ahmadiyyas at Ahmednagar and scheduled to start on Friday – said Jahid was stabbed to death. Jahid was tasked with maintaining discipline on the premises. When the western side of the venue came under attack, he and several others were there to resist it, Tabshir said. The attackers beat him mercilessly, he added. "After perpetrators noticed he was unconscious, they took him to the banks of Karatoa river, a few 100 yards away from the Jalsa premises, and stabbed him in the head and neck, leaving him dead," Tabshir mentioned. The convener of the Jalsa said the annual congregation was held there for 72 years peacefully. A section of fanatic people first attacked the Jalsa in 2019, postponing the occasion, he claimed. Last year, the programme was held as usual.

Bawalis unloading Nipa palm leaves from a goyna nouka, a type of boat, on the banks of the Bhairab in Khulna city. Every year, Bawalis, or woodcutters, who work contractually under traders, get permission from the forest department to collect the fronds for two months. This year, the permission was granted to them on January 28. Once they collect enough leaves, they take them to different wholesale markets, where these are sold at Tk 200-220 per 80 pieces. The leaves are generally used in the construction of huts and shacks by locals.

Of grief and resilience

Families of Sitakunda blast victims mourn at CMCH; several orgs offer support

The explosion at Sheema oxygen Plant in Chattogram's Sitakunda upazila has left the families of the victims grief-stricken and in deep shock. At the Chattogram Medical College and Hospital, where many of the injured were taken for treatment, the atmosphere is somber as family members wait anxiously for news of their loved ones. Many have spent hours outside the hospital gates, praying for their loved ones to recover. The situation is especially difficult for those who have lost family members in the blast, which occurred on the night of March 3. However, the hospital staffers have been trying their best to treat the injured, said the victim families. They have been working tirelessly to ensure that the patients receive the best possible care while also providing comfort and support to their families, they added. The outpouring of support from the community has also been heartwarming. Many social organisations, including Gausia Committee Bangladesh have come together to donate blood, money and other essential

supplies to the hospital. The support has been a beacon of hope for the families of the victims. 'LIFE ENGULFED BY UNCERTAINTY' Selim Richil was the only earning member of his four-member family. Hailing from Netrakona, Selim worked at

the filling section of Sheema Oxygen Plant in Sitakunda, Chattogram. He was among the six people who were killed in an explosion at the plant Saturday afternoon. Selim passed away at Chittagong Medical College Hospital. The family members came to the hospital and identified his body yesterday. This correspondent met Lily Marak, Selim's wife, at the hospital. She was sitting in front of the emergency department. She wasn't in any condition to speak to this correspondent. She just kept staring at the wall in front of her. Maybe, she was thinking of her two children and what will happen to them. According to Lily's relatives, Selim and Lily got married six years ago. Her father is a tea garden worker. They used to live at Neptune tea garden in Fatikchhari, while Selim lived in a mess in Sitakunda, said Jharna Rema, one of their relatives. 3 dead, 4 hurt in Munshiganj road accident

Three people died and four others were injured as a covered van collided with a microbus on the Dhaka Chattogram highway at Dori Bausia in Gajaria upazila of Munshiganj yesterday morning. The deceased were identified as Dulal Mia, 60, of Uttar Balrampur village in Cumilla's Titas, Md Hossain, 10, son of Akhter Hossain of the same village and Zaheer, a bus driver. Bhaberchar Highway Police Outpost Sub-inspector Riyad said the accident happened around 3:30am when the microbus carrying six persons was heading towards Titas upazila from Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport in Dhaka. When the microbus reached in Bausia on the highway, the covered van hit the vehicle from behind. The microbus overturned leaving Dulal and Hossain dead on the spot. At that time, a Dhaka-bound bus of Shanti Paribahan collided with a roadside tree while trying to avoid the microbus, SI Riyad said. Zaheer died on the spot. According to Gazaria Upazila Health Complex sources, all the injured were given first aid and sent to Dhaka. Bodies of the deceased were kept in police custody. The covered van was seized but the driver and helper fled the scene.

DESTINY GROUP HC extends bail of ex-army chief Harun in graft case
