

Hindus living in fear after temples attacked

The Hindu community in Kurigram's Ulipur municipal area is living in fear as police could not arrest anyone involved in the vandalism of two temples over the last two days. They fear further attacks as the culprits are still on the loose.

On Wednesday night, the Khewarpar Battala Kali Mandir in Ulipur Municipal area was attacked and its idol vandalised.

The next morning, miscreants broke into the Joddarpara Sannyasitala Kali

Mandir and took its idol away. Police could not recover the missing

Sudipta Dev Dhrubo, general secretary

of Sannyasitala Kali Mandir Committee, said just like every other day, he went to the temple on Thursday morning but saw the gate broken and the idol missing.

"We are panicking," he told this correspondent.

Soumendra Prasad Pandey Gaba, president of Ulipur Upazila Puja Udjapan Parishad, a group of criminals is carrying out these activities to create an untoward situation in the area.

He demanded the immediate arrest of the perpetrators.
