people of Kachua Sadar; we do not get this water [through the pipelines]."
Shahida Begum, a local, said, "I collect at least 40 jars of water from the plant every day and sell those to different shops and households in my locality."
Kachua DPHE Deputy Assistant Engineer Raihan Hossain said, "Pond and canal water is first taken into the treatment plant's reserve tank, then through sand filtration to the clear water tank. Later, the water is transferred to the service tank, from where the freshwater is delivered to people's homes via supply lines."
Kachua UNO Tasmina Khatun said, "We recognise the demand for more water plants as we are determined to provide pure water to every resident."

Saha, president of the Langalband Bathing Festival Celebration Committee. Visitors brought with them ritual ingredients such as flowers, grasses, fruits, Tulsi leaves, and mango leaves, as they bathed in the Brahmaputra River throughout the day. A folk fair was also organised on the bank of the river.
Many devotees expressed satisfaction with the management and security measures in place. In 2015, a stampede during the bathing festival resulted in the death of ten people. Since then, the authorities have been vigilant and taken all necessary measures to ensure a safe and organized event.
Superintendent of Police in Narayanganj Golam Mostofa Rasel stated that around 1,200 policemen were deployed to provide security to the devotees. Despite this, heavy traffic created a 20-kilometre-long tailback on the Dhaka-Chittagong highway yesterday morning.
An 85-year-old woman named Ekadashi Rajbangshi, who came from Munshiganj with her family, said, "I'm nearing the end of my life. I have come here to seek God's blessings for purifying my sins."
Another devotee, Dipty Saha, who was injured in the 2015 event, expressed satisfaction with the improved management and security measures this year.

He questioned, "If the Ansar members were not involved in the incident, how can a man die in their custody?"
Questioned why law enforcers did not arrest the accused Ansar members despite being informed of their identities, OC Utpal Barua said police have yet to establish their involvement.
He said investigation is ongoing, and the two would be apprehended once their involvement is confirmed.
Utpal mentioned that they have collected video footage from the hospital and are verifying its authenticity.
Hira and Mahbub could not be contacted despite repeated attempts.
