legal action against those who continue to violate the rules by running campaigns.

In response to the warning, Anwaruzzaman stated that his campaign cell had not yet started their electoral campaign, and they had not printed any leaflets. He claimed that some supporters were running campaigns using the boat symbol and he would address the issue internally.

Babul claimed to be unaware of electoral rules and stated that he had not yet received the cautionary letter from the EC.

On the other hand, Mahmudul said to the best of his understanding, they were not violating electoral rules, as the leaflets he distributed were only intended as introductory materials to familiarise people with his candidacy.

Syed Kamal Hossain, staff officer (media relations) of the EC in Sylhet, confirmed that the RO had issued a warning letter to all mayoral candidates. He said the assistant returning officers were monitoring the situation on the field and would soon take legal action against any violation.

ownership before the HC by suppressing fact of his losing a legal battle in the court of settlement in a case over the same property, said Deputy Attorney General Kazi Mynul Hassan.

Details of the SC order could not be known as its full text was not released yet.

On November 21 last year, the HC delivered verdict after holding hearing on two petitions filed by Abed Khan and the government.

DAG Mynul Hassan said the owners of the land left the country in 1972 and the then government took the possession of the land as an abandoned property.

Journalists Abed Khan, Toab Khan and eight others filed a case with the first settlement court claiming the ownership of the land in 1989. Abed and his brother said their father, Abdul Hakim Khan had purchased the land.

with the assistance of the higher authorities to avoid being arrested and then re-joined after receiving the go-ahead from the CID report.

THE FINAL REPORT
In the final report, CID mentioned that after his release, Mustakim first went to Chattogram General Hospital for treatment, where the on-duty doctors suggested him go to Chattogram Medical College Hospital.

The report stated Mustakim said he did not go to CMCH fearing further police harassment. However, he submitted an outdoor patient ticket with the case documents, proving otherwise. Besides, Mustakim alleged that the OC kicked his mother at CMCH during the protest, which the CID report said was also not true.

Bangladesh Human Rights Foundation (BHRF) is providing legal support to Mustakim in court. Advocate Zia Habib Ahasan of BHRF said, "According to the law, the complainant should be informed before any agency submits a final report. But in this case, he was not informed."

Mustakim could not be contacted for comments despite repeated attempts.

Commission for Asia and the Pacific (UNESCAP) on "Accelerating Climate Action in Asia and the Pacific for Sustainable Development" held in Bangkok, Thailand.

She said Bangladesh has been hosting 1.2 million forcibly displaced Myanmar nationals.

"Their overdue presence not only poses a serious security threat but also triggers a severe environmental degradation," she said.

She reiterated her call to take concerted efforts to send them back to their homes in Myanmar.

Hasina put forward four proposals for UNESCAP for the betterment of the world to face the climate change.

The proposals include adequate finance for climate-vulnerable developing countries, making trade facilitation measures, digital trade and

IT-enabled services available in the developing countries and strengthening sub-regional cooperation.

Hasina mentioned that Bangladesh is one of the most climate-vulnerable countries in the world although its contribution to global emission is very negligible.

"Our development programmes, therefore, focus on addressing climate-resilient development efforts," she told the conference.

She mentioned that the government has adopted the "Bangladesh Delta Plan 2100", a 100-year strategic plan, for achieving a safe, climate-resilient prosperous delta.

"Let us join our hands together to consolidate our partnership to fight against the perilous threats of Climate Change and make the world a safer and better place for our future generation," she said.

According to the letter, the chairman said, "Everything is done by bypassing the board. Dhaka Wasa is not functioning as per the Dhaka Wasa Act-1996. As a result, the board cannot enforce its authority."

Dhaka Wasa Sramik Union President Tasadduk Hossain and Engineers Association President Waz Uddin Wazed confirmed that they sent the letter to the ministry.

Abdur Rab Miah, president of Dhaka Wasa Diploma Engineers Association, declined to comment on the matter.

Contacted, Mostofa said, "None of the officials and employees of Wasa suffered damages due to my remarks. I believe no one from the agency filed the complaint against me on their own. They did it under pressure."

On October 30 last year, a section of the Wasa staff complained to the local government ministry against Mostafa, alleging that the chairman meddled in the daily and administrative affairs of Wasa.
