Today is the third death anniversary of Imamul Kabir Shanto, founder chairman of Shanto-Mariam Foundation, Shanto-Mariam University of Creative Technology and Sundarban Courier Service (Pvt) Ltd.
Imamul Kabir Shanto, also a freedom fighter and social worker, died from Covid-19 at Combined Military Hospital on May 30 at the age of 66.

Girl abducted again by same

her captivity and returned home, said her father.
On June 10, 2020, her father filed a case against Arif with Lalmonirhat Sadar Police Station, on charges of abducting and raping his daughter.
Two days later, Arif was arrested. Police submitted the charge sheet before a court against Arif on September 27, 2020. The case is currently under trial in court.
However, Arif got bail after seven months. The victim stopped going to school since then, her father told The Daily Star.
Meanwhile, Arif continued to stalk her whenever she went out of her house. On May 10, she was going to a relative's house, when Arif and his

cohorts abducted her again. "Some locals, who witnessed the incident, told us that Arif and his men abducted my daughter again. She has remained traceless since then," said the victim's father, who filed a written complaint with the same police station on May 12.
"We are in a state of constant anxiety. We want her back and we want justice," said the victim's mother.
Local union parishad member Abdus Salam confirmed the incident and said, "Arif used to stalk the girl. We arranged social arbitration on two occasions last year and warned Arif against this behaviour. However, he did not pay any heed to us."
Contacted over the phone, Arif's wife declined to comment on the matter. Lalmonirhat Sadar Police Station's Officer-in-Charge Ershadul Alam said they have received the complaint and are currently trying to rescue the girl and arrest the accused.
The district's Superintendent of Police Shaiful Islam said police are seriously looking into the matter and will take legal action upon investigation.
Teesta Degree College's principal Abdus Salam said he did not know whether Arif served in prison over a rape charge and informed this correspondent that Arif is currently on leave.
"I will take departmental action if anyone files a written complaint with me," he added.

Kayser Kamal said Taposh's comment about the civil society is preplanned and a criminal offence.
Meanwhile, ruling Awami League backed lawyers' organisation - Bangabandhu Awami Ainjibi Parishad - held a "peace meeting" on the Supreme Court Bar Association office premises protesting the "anarchy" by pro-BNP lawyers.
SCBA secretary Md Abdun Nur Dulal led the programme.

BNP Moniruzzaman Khan said, "We have not sent the letter yet. The list has been prepared by the central committee, so it will take the decision accordingly."
He admitted that Rupon does not hold any post in the party and he was not involved in BNP's politics in Barishal.
"However, he was involved with Chhatra Dal at some point in the past. Moreover, he introduced himself as a BNP man during his electoral campaigns. The centre may have added his name for this reason," Moniruzzaman told The Daily Star.
Rupon's father Ahsan Habib Kamal was the president of the Barishal City unit BNP and the fisheries affairs secretary of the central committee. He was elected Barishal's mayor as a BNP candidate in the city corporation elections in 2013.
BNP has a large vote bank in Barishal. Apart from Kamrul Ahsan, at least 20 current and former BNP leaders are running for the councillors' offices, ignoring the party's decision to boycott the polls.
Of them, several aspirants are incumbent councillors and the rest of

them are strong contenders in their respective wards.
If pro-BNP voters go to the polling centres, being convinced by the councillor aspirants from BNP, Rupon may appear as a strong contender in the mayoral race.
When asked about the recommendation, Kamrul Ahsan Rupon told this newspaper, "I'm a member of the BNP family, a

the treatment of vehicles at intersection points is the most important aspect for increasing the capacity of a road.
"However, we tend to just widen the roads without removing bottlenecks at the intersections," he said.
He opined that flyovers should be at the periphery

of a city. Yet, when it comes to planning our flyovers, many were built inside the city, proving to be nothing but counterproductive.
In addition, he said developing MRTs (Mass Rapid Transits) or BRTs (Bus Rapid Transits), without integrating them with the feeder roads will not yield the desired outcome.

Road Transport and Highways Division Secretary ABM Amin Ullah Nuri emphasised taking lessons from the workshop and implementing those in the development projects.
