Three persons were killed and four injured when a truck hit a CNG-run auto-rickshaw on Lalmonirhat-Burimari highway in Kaliganj upazila on Friday night.

The deceased were identified as Rafiqul Islam, 42, Mizanur Rahman, 36, and Munni Begum, 45.

Habibur Rahman, officer in charge of Kaliganj Police Station, said the accident took place around 11:00pm in Kakina area when the stone-laden truck hit the Rangpur-bound auto-rickshaw, leaving its three passengers dead on the spot.

Liton started prioritising employment in his election manifesto in 2013, and the issue topped his priorities during the 2018 RCC polls.

He had then promised that he would achieve the goal by providing natural gas connections to industries and building

a high-tech park, among other proposed initiatives.

However, natural gas connections reached Rajshahi in 2012 and residents have been struggling to get the connection for both household and industrial purposes. Meanwhile, the Bangabandhu Hi-tech Park was set up in 2016 and it is yet to create the promised 14,000 jobs.

When asked by journalists about the absence of civic issues -- such as increasing traffic jams, lack of proper bus stands and market spaces -- in his manifesto, Liton said, "No issue will be left unaddressed once I'm re-elected."

Maruf Hossain, town manager at UNDP, emphasised the need to reduce the reliance on plastic products and enforce rules where polythene is extensively used.

Prof Adil Mohammad Khan of Jahangirnagar University highlighted the urgency of implementing the government's

instructions on single-use plastic.

He said numerous countries have successfully banned such plastics and effective measures must be taken in Bangladesh as well.

Regarding the closure of polythene factories, Adil clarified that the government does not have a direct role in shutting down

plastic production facilities. However, he acknowledged the benefits of halting plastic production.

Shamim Ahmed, president of the Bangladesh Plastic Goods Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BPGMEA), stated,

"There is a need for more stringent waste disposal practices and I encourage

researchers to investigate polythene alternatives."

Speaking as the chief guest, Syeda Rizwana Hassan, chief executive of Bangladesh Environmental Lawyers Association (Bela), highlighted the easy availability of plastic products and stressed the importance of collective efforts to abandon them.


