The mayor said they could make people aware during the pandemic and they can now play a similar role regarding dengue.

The total number of deaths in dengue was 281 last year while the total number of cases was 62,382, of whom 23,162 were from outside Dhaka, according to the DGHS.

Councillor candidates the centre of attention

Voters have been showing more interest towards councillor candidates rather than mayoral ones in the upcoming Khulna City polls, scheduled for June 12.

They said no strong candidate is running the mayoral race against the Awami League candidate.

Meanwhile, there is considerable enthusiasm among voters for councillor candidates. As no party, including the ruling Awami League, is endorsing councillor candidates, they are tirelessly campaigning to win over voters.

In most wards, BNP leaders have chosen not to participate in the councillor elections. Eight BNP members who defied the party's decision and are contesting for councillor positions, have been expelled from the party.

In 26 out of the city's 31 general wards, several Awami League leaders are competing for councillor positions. Similarly, in all 10 wards reserved for women, multiple party leaders are vying for these positions.

In the current election, AL has a single candidate in only five out of the 31 general wards of the city corporation. These candidates include SM Khurshid Ahmed Tona in ward 13, ZA Mahmood Don in

ward 24, Ali Akbar Tipu in ward 25, Golam Maula Shanu in ward 26, and Rafiuddin Ahmed Rafi, who is the brother of the current army chief.

Additionally, two AL supporters from ward 13 and ward 27 have been elected unopposed as councillors.

Md Babul Rana, general secretary of the AL city unit, said the party has extended support to the candidate from ward 27, while the remaining wards are open.

Analysing the data, it was found that four out of the five candidates in ward 3 are AL supporters. Incumbent councillor Abdus

Salam, AL ward general secretary Maksud Hasan Piku, Sramik League leader Abzal Jamaddar, and city unit Jubo League member Kazi Ibrahim Marshall are all councillor candidates. Similar scenarios are seen in most of the wards.

Mahbub Kaiser, former joint secretary of the Khulna City unit BNP and councillor candidate for ward 22, expressed that voters are eager to vote for them. "Voters will not consider party affiliation when voting for councillors. They will choose candidates based on their previous records and credentials."

Budget reflects no

Research & Development (CPRD), Centre for Sustainable Rural Livelihood (CSRL), EquityBD, An Organisation for Socio-Economic Development (AOSED)-Khulna, Climate Action Network on South Asia-Bangladesh (CANSABD) and LEDARS Satkhira jointly came up with this demand in a discussion held at the capital's Jatiya Press Club.

Addressing the event, Syed Aminul Hoque, director of COAST Foundation, stressed that successful implementation of government plans, such as the Delta Plan 2100, Mujib Climate Prosperity Plan 2030, and National Determined Plan, require an annual allocation of around 3.2 percent of the GDP.

Jiaul Haque Mukta, president of CSRL, called for skillful planning and adequate allocation of funds for climate change adaptation.

Shamsuddoha, executive director of CPRD, highlighted the concerned ministries' lack of capability to effectively utilise financial resources and implement project-based planning.

"Separate climate finance mechanism is required to overcome this challenge," he said.

Ferdous Ara Rume, co-director of the COAST Foundation, demanded climate financing as part of a safety net programme for climate-vulnerable women.

Rezaul Karim Chowdhury, executive director of COAST Foundation and moderator of the session, suggested that disaster risk reduction, social development, technical education, and employment generation programmes could be effectively implemented under this comprehensive plan, ensuring a strong protection system for the coastal population.

The wages and benefits of journalists, employees and press workers, artists of broadcast, online, and print media outlets would be fixed under the proposed law.

of Environment (DoE), Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner, director of (Dhaka metropolitan) DoE, OC of Shyampur Model Police station, councillor of ward 47 Shahana Akhtar, and Noushad Ahmed, Md Zakir Hossain and others.

In the notice, they stated that filling up the pond without serving any national interest is an illegal, punishable offence, regardless of its ownership.

The DIT plot pond is on a land of around 4 acres. A total of 13.59 acres of adjacent land were acquired

in favour of Rajdhani Uন্নয়ন কার্ত্রিপাক্ষা (Rajuk).

Later, one Noushad Ahmed and others filed a petition to the High Court to release the land. The court ordered in favour of the petitioner. Rajuk's appeals were dismissed.

On June 2, locals announced a siege programme and human chain to protect the over sixty-year-old pond. However, the programme was cancelled as the organisers did not have authorisation from the police.

GRAMEEN KALYAN, TELECOM TRUST

HC bench sends 13 petitions to CJ

A High Court bench yesterday refused to continue the hearing of 13 petitions, filed by Grameen Kalyan and Grameen Telecom Trust, and sent those to the chief justice for a decision.

The two nonprofitable and charitable companies established by Nobel Laureate Dr Muhammad Yunus, filed the petitions – five writ and eight income tax reference applications – since 2015 to 2020 challenging the legality of the government imposing several hundred crores of taka as income tax.

Chief Justice Hasan Fozz Siddique may now assign another HC bench for hearing and disposing of the petitions.

Yesterday, the HC bench of Justice Md Iqbal Kabir Lytton and Justice SM Maniruzzaman passed the order as Justice Maniruzzaman had been involved in the cases as a party on behalf of the state when he was a deputy attorney general before he was appointed as judge of this court.

Petitioners' lawyer Fida M Kamal had earlier mentioned this point before the bench during hearing of the petitions.

Attorney General AM Amin Uddin represented the state during the hearing.

Rajshahi, Arani, Abdulpur and Ishwari stations, he said. However, they will allow mangoes from other stations too if a large amount of the fruit is pre-booked from those stations, he added.

To transport a kg of mango, one has to pay Tk 1.3, he added. The mango session in Chapainawganj started in the third week of May this year and will continue till mid-July, while mango harvesting in Rajshahi formally started on May 4 and gained

momentum from May 15. On May 16, Deputy Commissioner of Chapainawganj AKM Galiv Khan said BR will launch Mango Special Train from May 20.

Asked about the delay, a top BR official, requesting anonymity, said a number of important issues including inauguration of Chilahati Express by PM on June 4, activities related to the handover ceremony of 20 Indian locomotives on May 23, left little time for launching the service this year.

correspondent saw that trees are being cut on both sides of the road from the Kagmari intersection to Shamsan Ghat in Tangail town. Among those felled trees were mango, mahogany and banyan trees.

Azad Khan Bhasani, grandson of Maulana Abdul Hamid Khan Bhasani and a Santosh resident, said among the trees cut on both sides of the road for development were many ancient ones from the zamindari period.

"These trees provided us with fruits and shade... The future generations will never see such old trees again."

"There is no doubt that the country is becoming increasingly unlivable with the rising heat over time. On the other hand, trees are being cut down indiscriminately, further contributing to the disaster. The authorities concerned should strive to implement any development plan in the future without harming trees," he added.
